

# National Trust Old Church Lodge Accessibility Guide

Old Church Lodge The Duver St Helens PO33 1XZ

#### Introduction

- A small and cosy, stone built detached single storey Victorian cottage located near to the seashore in the hamlet of Duver, close to St Helens
- The cottage comprises of sitting and dining room with open fire, kitchen, twin bedroom and double bedroom, small shower room with WC and utility room accessed from the patio area.
- Garden with a low wall and hedging. Parking for 2 cars
- The Duver, a stretch of sand and shingle look after by the National Trust is frequented by seabirds and other wildlife.
- Surrounding countryside is fairly level, access to shoreline and beach is reasonably good
- The village of St Helens is about a quarter of a mile from the cottage and has a range of shops, pub, restaurants and medical centre
- Old Church Lodge is situated about 10 minutes walk from the number 8 Southern Vectis bus route from Ryde to Newport via Sandown
- No WI-FI. Telephone signal is reasonable.
- Heating is provided by gas central heating with additional electric towel rail in the bathrooms



- The cottage is decorated in neutral creams and light beige with highlights of soft sea greens and blue
- Crockery blue and white

#### Approach, arrival and parking

- The cottage is reached from the B3330 turning off onto Duver Road and following a tarmac road downhill, just before the road turns to the right at the bottom (becoming single track). The cottage and parking area is situated on the right-hand side.
- Gravelled car parking area for 2 cars is accessed directly off the road
- Side gate accessed from the parking area onto a gravel path to the back door used as the main entrance
- The garden is fenced by a hedge on two sides at the rear and a low wall on 2 side at the front
- Outside lighting, above entrance doors and on the side of the building with a switch located on the corner of the building







## Getting in (and out) of the cottage

- A gravel path of 20m leads to a paved area around the back of the cottage, gravel is deep in places
- The path is clear and well lit
- Outside lights are located outside the kitchen door, along the side of the building and over the front porch
- The key safe is located on the right-hand side of the kitchen door at 160cm from ground level
- A small but wide step up of 17cm and a width of 40cm, door weather bar 5cm
- Door width of 75cm, leads into the kitchen
- The area is covered by a glass roof









- Entering through the front porch, small threshold of 6cm and step down 12cm front door entrance. Threshold of 18cm into dining room. Door handle
- Outside light over door
- Location of the log store





The main entrance point is the back door, not the front porch

## Getting around the cottage

 Entering the kitchen, the internal door leads to a small lobby area and sitting-dining room. To the left-hand side is the twin room, ahead the shower room and door to the right-hand side the double room



## **Sitting & Dining Room**

- 3-seater sofa with a seat height of 44cm, arms 60cm and back 80cm high. Soft cushions
- Armchair at 49cm high with firm cushion
- 23" TV with integrated DVD, Freesat
- Open fireplace with mantel over
- Wall mirror and bookshelves



- Set of side tables 46cm, 47cm, 50cm in height
- Low window, 59cm sill facing north and east, curtains on poles





- Table 79cm high and 4 chairs with seat height of 47cm, back 88cm
- Front door opens into dining area, yale style lock and a handle, curtain on pole. This is not used as the main entrance point
- Wooden floor with rug
- Light provided by table lamp with switch at the neck, floor lamp with switch at the neck and an angle poise lamp with a touch button on the base

## **Kitchen**

- Yale style lock and handle
- Kitchen comprises of a selection of wall and undercounter cabinets
- Worktop height at 92cm
- Electric double oven with 4 hot plates, controls on the front at 80cm high
- Sink and half sink with drainer, leaver handles and arch over mixer tap
- Fridge freezer
- Full size dishwasher
- Cordless kettle, toaster, radio
- 6 Recessed spotlights
- 2 windows facing west with roman blinds
- Tiled floor
- Fire alarm control point, fire blanket, fire action notice
- Door to lobby, width between fridge-freezer and door 75cm







#### **Twin Bedroom**

- An L-shaped room
- 2 single beds with pine headboard and a mattress height of 60cm
- 1 bedside cabinet with draw
- 1 chest of drawers
- 2 bedside lights with switch on the base
- Mirror
- North facing window with curtains on poles
- Pendant lighting
- Carpet flooring
- Decorated in neutrals with highlights of blue





#### **Double Bedroom**

- Door width 70cm with door stop
- Double bed with pine headboard and a mattress height of 66cm
- 2 bedside cabinets, lamps with switches on the cable
- Free standing wardrobe
- Chest of drawers
- Decorative chair with a seat height of 46cm
- Caretakers cupboard
- Windows- East facing -bay, with a window seat 55cm high and South facing. Curtains on poles
- Mirror
- Pendant light
- Carpet flooring
- Decorated in neutrals with highlights of soft sea green







#### **Shower Room**

- Towel rail booster button located outside shower room door
- Extractor fan main power switch is at ceiling height outside the door
- Shower cubical 75cm x 75cm with sliding doors and twist taps mounted vertically, threshold of 12cm
- Sink at 85cm high with pillar taps, mirror over
- Toilet with a seat height of 44cm, tall cistern with the flush at 97cm high
- Wall and ceiling light
- · Radiator and electric towel rail
- Wood effect vinyl flooring



# **Utility cupboard**

- · Light switch on the right-hand side
- Door with handle, 10cm threshold
- Hook and catch on outside to secure door
- Frosted window facing south
- Utility cupboard contains ladders
- Log basket
- Highchair and travel cot
- Iron and board
- Location of the gas boiler
- Washing machine 6kg
- 800W microwave
- P50 Extinguisher







## Garden

- Front and sides are laid to lawn with a paved area near to the kitchen door
- A greengage tree is situated outside the kitchen
- Wooden outside furniture. Square table 76cm high and 4 armed chairs with a seat height of 43cm, arm 65cm and back 90cm
- Gravel pathway
- Hedges and some shrubs
