Introduction

- Dairy Cottage is a single storey 2-bedroomcottage in a cluster of cottages converted from old farm buildings on the Stackpole Estate
- The Cottage lies in undulating landscape close to the coast and is approached via narrow country lanes
- All main living area and bedrooms have south west facing windows
- The Cottage comprises a twin bedroom, double bedroom, bathroom with shower over bath & WC and sitting/dining room with kitchen off to one side

Pre-Arrival

- Directions provided with booking
- Bring torch if arriving in dark as there are no street lights here



Approach

- Cottage is approximately 50 yards from car park. Approach to cottage has thick gravel surface
- Cottage is immediately to the right (as facing) of two double storey cottages



Arrival & Parking Facilities

• A car park for all eight cottages is situated behind the Granary. It is not possible to park in the courtyard. From the car park access is either over a small slate slab or down three stone and slate steps (no handrail), each 19 cm high. Once out of the car park the path is gravel chippings. Dairy Cottage adjoins a two-storey cottage to the left (as facing) and a group of three single storey cottages to the right around the gravel courtyard.

Getting in (and out) of the cottage

- One high step 200mm to front door. Metal rain bar. Key safe to left of door. Door 720mm wide
- No other doors from outside

Getting around the cottage

Level access throughout the cottage

- Quarry tiled flooring throughout with loose rugs
- Corridors 750mm wide with 90 degree turn from hallway to bedrooms and bathroom and from hallway to kitchen and sitting room

Kitchen

- Height of worktops is 940mm
- Electric cooker with ceramic hob
- Microwave, dishwasher, undercounter fridge, separate freezer, dishwasher, toaster and cordless kettle
- Lever taps to sink
- One overhead, one hob light and one strip light under wall unit
- Separate shared laundry facilities on-site washing machine and dryer

Bathroom

- WC, basin and bath with shower over bath
- The WC is 410mm high
- Bath is 1690mm long, 560mm high and 690mm wide
- The gap beside the bath is narrow at 460mm
- The bath has small integral grab handles to either side
- The basin is 810mm high
- The over bath shower unit has a press on/off mechanism

Sitting/Dining Room

- One three-seater sofa with seat height of 480mm
- One armchair with seat height of 480mm
- Multi-fuel stove
- Radio
- One central light and one table lamp with LED bulbs.
- Oval wooden dining table with four wooden chairs. Table has 585mm clear knee space underneath
- Multi-fuel stove

Twin Bedroom

- Two single beds
- Firm mattresses- 900mm wide
- Bed height 650mm
- Mattress length 1900mm
- Both beds against the wall on one side with central aisle between.
- One bedside lamp

Double Bedroom

- 1800mm wide double bed with zip-linked mattresses that can be converted to twin beds
- Bed height 620mm, mattress length 1900mm

Garden

- Table and chairs on gravel area at front of cottage
- Shared open garden area to the other side of the neighbouring cottages on the route to the cliff edge. Garden is not enclosed and has a rough grass surface.
- Coastal path accessible from garden area

Additional Information

Payphone in laundry, outgoing calls only.

- Central heating
- Multi-fuel stove with sufficient fuel to get it started. Further fuel to be obtained by guests.
- · Assistance dogs are welcome at all our cottages
- Pets other than assistance dogs cannot be accommodated here
- In the event of a fire, it is the responsibility of the guests to evacuate themselves. Please contact us if you required any specific access requirements in this respect



Facilities at all cottages
