## Pitching up

Please pitch your tent on the spot indicated by staff, or as marked on the map, so that we can safely space out campers across the site. Tents must always be 6m apart.

To ensure a relaxing and safe stay for all, please follow the site rules:

- No visitors
- Quiet time is 10pm – 7am
- Leave no trace, use bins and recycling points  
Birds and wildlife can be attracted to your food waste. Please do not leave unattended rubbish bags outside your accommodation.
- Fires must be contained and raised off the ground
- Dogs are welcome on site but please keep on a lead and clean up after them
