Introduction

- Enlli is one of the Henfaes holiday apartments situated in Henfaes house.
- The apartment can accommodate four people.
- Central heating throughout.
- Rear garden shared with other Henfaes holiday apartments.
- Parking is available on the adjacent National Trust car park
- The cottage, also known as the Upside-Down house, is arranged as follows:

Ground Floor:

- Access is to the side of the Henfaes building. Entry is into a small hallway with tall cupboard and hanging space. Straight ahead is the bathroom. To the left is the twin bedroom and to the right is the double bedroom.

First Floor:

- Staircase leads to the upstairs rooms. There is a door into the lounge and a further door into the kitchen/dining area. Double doors lead onto the patio roof terrace with seating area

Pre-Arrival

- See the main webpage for booking and location details.
- Please contact us prior to booking if you have any specific access requirements.
- Directions provided with booking.

- Bring torch if arriving in the dark as there are no streetlights here.

Approach

- The cottage is in the centre of Aberdaron at the entrance to the large National Trust car park. Guests need to follow the information sent with the booking information with care.

Arrival & Parking Facilities

Parking is in the previously mentioned National Trust car park. The key safe is in a black box outside the entrance door to the right (as facing). It is operated by a push button mechanism. A torch is recommended especially if arriving in the dark as the numbers on the box can be difficult to see. The key is returned to the key safe on departure.

Getting in (and out) of the cottage

- There is a small lip/step at the entrance to the apartment which measures 4cm.
- The front door has a clear opening width of 75.5cm.



Getting around the cottage

Ground Floor

- Level access from front door throughout ground floor.
- Internal door widths on the ground floor are all 74cm.
- Width of hallway at narrowest point is 72cm.
- The ground floor is carpeted apart from the bathroom which has a lino floor covering.
- The 11 stairs to the first floor are 77cm wide with the height of the risers being 19cm.
- Bannister rail to the left-hand side is 81cm.



First floor:

- At the top of the stairs to get into the lounge there is a further step into the lounge of 19cm.
- The width of all internal doors on the first floor is 74cm.
- Level access throughout the first floor.
- There are laminated floorboards throughout the first floor.



Step at top of stairs into lounge

Sitting Room

One sofa with seat height of 46cm.
Two armchairs with seat height of 43cm.
Standard lamp and main light.
Good natural light from the two windows.
Rug with non-slip backing covering floor in front of sofa.



Sitting room

Kitchen

- Height of worktop is 92.5cm.
- Electric cooker with ceramic top and fridge freezer.
- Fluorescent lighting.
- Electric toaster and kettle.
- Dining table with a height of 74cm and chairs with a seat height of 44cm.



Double Bedroom

- On ground floor.
- The bed is 70cm high x 135cm wide x 185cm long.
- Wooden bed.
- Vanity unit.



Twin Bedroom

- On ground floor.
- The beds are 68cm high x 98cm wide and 185cm long.
- Wooden beds.
- Chest of drawers with lamps between beds.
- Small rug with non slip backing.



Bathroom

- WC, basin and shower unit.
- The WC is 41cm high.
- The basin is 77cm high.
- Acrylic shower tray is 24cm high.

Garden

There is a patio roof terrace which is accessed through double doors in the kitchen. Patio table and chairs are available.

Additional Information

- Assistance dogs are welcome at all our cottages.
- Pets other than assistance dogs cannot be accommodated here.
- In the event of a fire, it is the responsibility of the guests to evacuate themselves. Vibrating fire/smoke detectors are available if requested at time of booking. Please contact us if you have any other specific access requirements in this respect.

Facilities at all cottages

The National Trust aims to expand the list of accessible /equipment/items available at each cottage and these may include

- Cordless kettle
- Hollowfibre bedding
- Chair with armrests
- Good reading light
- Large handle vegetable peeler
- Easy tin opener
- Non-slip mat for bath/shower
- Non-slip place mat
- Easy jar opener
- Information in alternative formats (on request)

Please note that we cannot guarantee that all items will be available at the time of your visit. Please enquire at the time of booking regarding any particular requests.
