Introduction

- Stone built, rectory barn.
- Glebe Cottage abuts the quiet lane that ends at Mawnan church.
- Carpet and vinyl floors and beamed ceiling living area.
- Rural setting.
- · Rointe heating.

Arrival & Parking Facilities

Glebe Cottage is reached by a narrow country road. The parking is at the side of the cottage on a hard, gravelled, area.





Getting in (and out) of the cottage

- From the parking area there is downward sloping, gravelled, path leading to the only entrance door.
- Slate slab inset into gravel abutting a granite threshold step.
- The combination key safe is on the wall to the left of the entrance door.



Getting around the cottage

Ground Floor

Front door opens straight into open plan lounge, dining, kitchen area. Stairway up to first floor.

First Floor

Stairs up from lounge to landing. Two doors off to bathroom and double bedroom.

Lounge / Dining room / Kitchen Open Plan:





- Wooden, part glazed, door 780 mm wide opens onto small, slate tiled floor area with inset door mat. Step, 220mm high, 850mm wide, up to living area.
- Open plan with beams, wooden flooring in lounge/dining. Vinyl flooring in kitchen.
- 11 spotlights.1 table lamp. Emergency light.
- 2 windows to front of property overlooking garden. One 780mm high and one 640mm.
- Wooden oblong table 750mm high, knee clearance 620mm, 1,200mm long and 880mm wide.
- 2 wooden chairs, 450mm seat height.
- Side table 400mm wide, 670mm long and 720mm high.
- Side table 270mm wide, 520mm long and 420mm high.
- 1 two seater sofa 450mm seat height.



- 1 winged back armchair, 480mm seat height.
- Wooden storage box 360mm high, 880mm long and 380mm wide.
- Electric log effect fire.
- 2 Fire Alarms.
- · TV DVD player.
- Radio/CD player.
- Open walkway 730mm wide to kitchen area.

Kitchen area:

- Vinyl flooring
- Floor cupboards and drawers under 920mm worktop.
- Electric cooker with 4 ring hob and extractor hood.
- · Dishwasher.
- Fridge with ice-box, washing machine, cordless kettle, microwave and toaster.
- Rechargeable torch.



Stairway and first floor landing





- 3 steps to half landing and 8 more to top landing, also 1 further step midway along landing. All steps 200mm high and 700mm wide.
- Fitted carpet.
- Fire Alarm
- Rointe heater.
- 2 wooden doors. 1 to bathroom other to double bedroom.



Bathroom

- Wooden door 690mm wide.
- Vinyl flooring.
- 1 window, to side, 1,110mm high from floor.
- 1 ceiling light.
- Wall mirror with light and shaver point.
- Heated towel rail.
- WC 400mm high.
- Washbasin 800mm high
- Bath 520mm high, 1,660mm long, 670mm wide.
- Electric shower over bath with glass shower panel.
- Extractor fan.
- Electric wall heater.



- Wooden door 720mm wide.
- 1 window to side 1,110mm high.
- 1 window to front, overlooking garden
 630mm high
- 2 ceiling lights and 2 bedside lamps.
- 1 double bed 600mm high, 2,000mm long and 1600mm wide.
- 2 wooden bedside cabinets 620mm high
- Wooden chest drawers '2 over 3' 840mm high, 1,030mm long and 520mm wide.
- Built in wooden wardrobe and airing cupboard 1,150mm wide (rail hanging height 1650mm)
- Wooden chair 400mm seat height.
- Fire Alarm.
- Rointe heater.
- Rechargeable torch.
