

## **National Trust Cottages Accessibility Guide**

#### Introduction

- Hayrick is part of a substantial stone and slate barn that has been converted into a two storey cottage.
- It is a comfortable cottage in a rural setting.
- It has views over the countryside.
- The cottage has night storage heating, convector heaters and a solid fuel stove.
- There are laundry facilities in a communal outbuilding.
- The land immediately around the cottage is reasonably flat.

The Cottage is arranged as follows: **Ground Floor:** Sitting room and kitchen/diner **First Floor:** double bedroom, twin bedroom and shower room.

## **Approach**

• The cottage is approached via country lanes signposted Polruan.

## **Arrival & Parking Facilities**

- Parking is in the communal unlit farmyard car parking area in front of the cottage.
- There is parking for two cars.
- The distance from the car park to the cottage is 5m.
- The car park is sloping and its surface consists of uneven rough gravel.






## Getting in (and out) of the cottage

- From the car park there is a 100mm step down to a cobbled area in front of the entrance door.
- There is a 80mm high wooden threshold into the cottage.
- The entrance door has a clear opening width of 710mm.
- The key safe is on the right-hand side of the door at a height of 1480mm from floor level. It
  is operated by a combination lock mechanism.
- There is an outside sensor activated light over the main door.
- There are no other doors leading to the outside.

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






#### Getting around the cottage

- Main entrance leads directly into sitting room.
- 12 stairs with a wooden handrail rise from the sitting room to the landing
- There is even access on each floor level
- There is a hard floor in the sitting room and the kitchen/diner, carpet on the stairs and in bedrooms and vinyl in the bathroom.
- The internal doors have clear opening widths of 560mm to 730mm





#### **Ground Floor**

### **Sitting Room**

- Door leading to the outside and door to kitchen.
- There is a multi-fuel stove.
- There are two ceiling lights and one table lamp.
- There is a sofa with a seat height of 450mm and two armchairs with a seat height of 420mm high.
- There is an occasional table at a height of 500mm.
- There is a TV and DVD player.
- Digital radio.
- There are views to the front, gardens and countryside.







#### **Kitchen**

- The height of worktop is 920mm
- Door to sitting room
- There is a ceramic hob and electric oven 900mm high with controls to front.
- The window looks out to the car park.
- There is a table and four chairs
- The table has a knee clearance of 610mm and chair seat height of 460mm.
- There is a fridge freezer, microwave, cordless kettle and toaster.
- There are 7 LED spotlights on a track.
- There is a window seat with a height of 500mm
- There is a pine crockery cupboard at a height of 1080mm









#### **Shower room**

- The shower room is off the landing.
- There is a walk-in shower
- Step height into shower 40mm
- Shower tray 1040mm x 540mm
- Shower cubicle width 630mm
- Shower control 1100mm from shower tray
- The WC is 430mm high.
- The basin 820mm.
- Shaver light and 4 ceiling spots.









#### **Twin Bedroom**

- Door from landing.
- There are two windows with outlooks to front and to the gardens/countryside
- There is one ceiling light and 2 table lamps.
- The twin beds are 900mm wide x 1900mm long x 610mm high.
- The clearance under the beds is 120mm.
- There is one bedside table 740mm high with a table lamp.
- There is a built-in wardrobe with rail at height of 1670mm
- There is a chest of drawers measuring 830mm high.
- There is a chair with a seat height of 450mm








#### **Double Bedroom**

- Door from landing
- There is a centralised double bed 1530mm x 1900mm x 700mm high.
- There is 40mm clearance under the bed.
- There are two bedside tables 470mm high with table lamps.
- There is also a central ceiling light.
- There is a built-in wardrobe with a clothes rail of 1700mm high.
- There is a chest of drawers measuring 880mm high.
- There is wooden chair, seat at 440mm





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#### Garden

- Large shared communal gardens with grass, trees and shrubs.
- The land is slightly sloping.
- There is a picnic table with fixed bench seating to the side of the cottage.
- There is a fixed brick BBQ.







## **Laundry Room**

- There are two washing machines and two tumble dryers in an outbuilding adjoining the Round House next to Fortescue cottage.
- This is approximately 30m from the car park on an uneven sloping grass and gravel path.
- There is a 130mm step into the laundry room and a 60mm threshold. There is a concrete floor.







#### Additional Information

- Assistance dogs are welcome at all our cottages
- In the event of a fire, it is the responsibility of the guests to evacuate themselves. Vibrating fire/smoke detectors are available if requested at time of booking. Please contact us if you have any other specific access requirements in this respect.

#### Facilities at all cottages

- Hollowfibre bedding
- Chair with armrests
- Good reading light
- Large handle vegetable peeler
- Easy tin opener
- Non-slip mat for bath/shower
