

National Trust Cottages Accessibility Guide

Orchard Cottage Gunby Hall Nr Spilsby Lincolnshire PE23 5SS



Introduction

- Orchard Cottage is a cottage sleeping 4 people located within the gardens of Gunby Hall.
- The cottage has 1 double bedroom and 1 twin bedroom and 1 shower room.
- The cottage has electric night storage heaters, a multi-fuel stove in the dining room and an open fire in the sitting room.
- Guests have access to the grounds and gardens of Gunby Hall after hours.

The cottage is arranged as follows:

Ground floor:

Entrance Lobby, Kitchen, Dining Room, Sitting room and downstairs shower room and WC.

First floor:

1 x double bedrooms with en-suite WC and 1 x twin bedroom.

Approach



Gunby Hall is well signed from the main approach roads. The cottage is approached by the main driveway to Gunby Hall.



Arrival & Parking Facilities



- On arrival on site guests are asked to park on the grass outside the archwasy to the courtyard of Gunby Hall (see image above).
 During periods when the ground is extremely wet, parking is permitted within the courtyard itself.
- The cottage can be accessed on foot only through the gardens of Gunby Hall. The gardens are accessed via the small gate in the L/H corner of the courtyard as you stand with the clocktower behind you. The total distance from the gate by the archway to the cottage door is 170 metres.
- There is both a trolley and a wheel barrow provided for transportation of luggage.







• The paths that approach the cottage are a mixture of stone flags and loose shingle. The stone flags may become slippery during wet weather and care should therefore be taken.

Getting in (and out) of the cottage



- The entrance door is 770mm wide and leads directly into the entrance lobby.
- The keysafe is located to the R/H side of the entrance door.



Getting around the cottage

- The cottage occupies two floor.
- There are fitted carpets throughout the cottage apart from in the kitchen, dining room, en-suite WC the bathroom which have tiled floors. There is underfloor heating to the kitchen and bathroom areas.

ENTRANCE LOBBY

- Small entrance lobby with hanging space for coats and small bench seat with storage baskets for shoes.
- Bench seat is 500mm high.
- Doors leading off of entrance lobby into sitting room and dining room.



Sitting Room



- Triple aspect room with views over gardens.
- Double doors from entrance lobby are 1480mm wide.
- Spacious room with open fire and 2 No.
 2 seater sofas with a seat height of 400 mm
- Wall lights to 2 No. elevations and 1 No. table lamp.
- 40" TV and DVD player.

Dining Room

- Dual aspect with room with views over garden to both sides.
- Doors leading off to kitchen and entrance lobby with width of 740mm
- Lighting is from a wall light fittings to 2 No. elevations and table lamp.
- Dining table with 4 No. dining chairs with a seat height of 490mm.
- CD/Radio with blue tooth connectivity.

Kitchen



- Dual aspect with views onto garden.
- Doorway from dining room is 740mm wide.
- The worktops are 910mm high.
- Kitchen includes a single builtunder oven, ceramic hob, dishwasher, fridge with ice box, and microwave.
- Flush fit ceiling pendants.

Shower Room

- Ground floor shower room with WC and wash hand basin.
- Shower cubicle measures 740mm x 740mm with step up of 90mm.
- Riser bar extends from 1400.mm to .2000mm
- WC seat height of 400mm ffl
- Wash hand basin measures 940mm to top of rim.



FIRST FLOOR

Bedroom 1 (Master Bedroom with En-suite WC)



- Cosy room with single aspect.
- Door into bedroom is 740mm wide.
- Kingsize sleigh bed with firm mattress.
- Flush spot lights and 2 No. bedside lamps.
- Built in cupboards with hanging space and storage shelving.
- En-suite WC with wash basin. Height of WC is 400mm ffl.



Twin Bedroom

- Single aspect room with views over garden.
- Door into bedroom is 740mm wide.
- Twin beds with firm mattress
- Flush spot lights and 2 No. bedside lamps.
- Wardrobe, chest of drawers and 2 No. bedside tables.



Garden





- Private garden to front, side and rear of cottage, level and mainly laid to grass.
- Rattan effect table with 4 No. chairs with seat height of 440mm, backrest and arm rests.

Additional Information

- Assistance dogs are welcome at all our cottages
- In the event of a fire, it is the responsibility of the guests to evacuate themselves. Vibrating
 fire/smoke detectors are available if requested at time of booking. Please contact us if you have any
 other specific access requirements in this respect.

Facilities at all cottages

The National Trust aims to expand the list of accessible /equipment/items available at each cottage and these may include

- Hollowfibre bedding
- Good reading light
- Large handle vegetable peeler
- Easy tin opener
- Non-slip mat for bath/shower
