Introduction

- Tiffy's is a single storey cottage located on St Anthony's Head.
- The bedroom and sitting room face the sea whilst the kitchen and bathroom face the rear.
- The cottage has night storage heating and convector heaters and electrorad heaters.
- Laundry facilities are in an outbuilding and shared with the other cottages.
- The land immediately around the cottage is reasonably flat.
- The paths around the cottages at St Anthony's Head can be slippery when wet.
- There is a firm and level footpath in front of the cottage.

The Cottage is arranged as follows:

The kitchen/diner, sitting room, double bedroom and bathroom are all situated on the ground level.

Pre-Arrival

- Directions provided with booking.
- Please bring a torch.

Approach

The cottage is approached via country lanes and sign posted St Anthony's Head.



Arrival & Parking Facilities

- Parking is adjacent to the cottage on a slightly sloping firm grass bank.
- The distance from the parking place to the cottage is 5m.
- There is a level flagged path to the front door from the main gravel path.
- The key safe is on the left hand side of the door at a height of 140cm ffl (from floor level). It is operated by a combination lock mechanism.
- There is an outside light over the main door.

Getting in (and out) of the cottage

- The main door has a clear opening width of 70cm.
- There is a metal threshold which is 3cm high.
- The door leads directly into the sitting room.
- There are no other doors leading outside.

Getting around the cottage

- There is level access throughout.
- There is a vinyl floor covering in the kitchen and bathroom.
- There is carpet in the sitting room and bedroom.
- Internal doors clear opening widths range from 65cm to 70cm.





Sitting Room

- The sitting room has doors to the kitchen, bedroom and outside/
- There are windows to the front and side.
- There is a central light fitting, a table lamp, and a standard lamp.
- There is a sofa with a seat height of 43cm and a winged armchair with a seat height of 46cm. Both have cushions.
- There is a TV and DVD player.
- There is a radio.





Kitchen

- Directly off the sitting room.
- The height of worktop is 90cm.
- There is an electric cooker with ceramic hob with controls to front which is 90cm high.
- There is a fridge freezer, microwave, cordless kettle and toaster.
- There are four ceiling spot lights and under cupboard lighting.
- There is a dining table and two chairs.
- The table has knee clearance of 62cm. The dining chairs are 47cm high.









Double Bedroom


- Door to sitting room and further door to bathroom.
- There is a centralised double bed 140cm wide x 190cm long x 65cm high.
- The clearance underneath the bed is 5cm.
- The gap from the foot of the bed to the storage heater is 32cm.
- There are two bedside tables 54cm 70cm high with table lamps.
- There is also a central ceiling light.
- There is a built-in wardrobe with a clothes rail at 140cm ffl.
- There is a stool with a seat height of 44.5cm.



Bathroom

- The bathroom is off the bedroom.
- The bath is standard and has an electric shower over its. There are no hand grips on the hath
- The WC is 42cm high.
- The basin is 77cm high.
- There is a central ceiling light fitting and shaver light.
- There is a heated towel rail.







Laundry Room

There is a washing machine and tumble dryer in the outbuilding behind the Majors, Captains and Lieutenants with level access. This room is approximately 30m from the cottage on a firm sloping grass surface.





Garden

- The garden is small, flat and open.
- The area is grass.
- There is a small table with two fixed chairs.

Additional Information

- Assistance dogs are welcome at all our cottages
- In the event of a fire, it is the responsibility of the guests to evacuate themselves. Vibrating fire/smoke detectors are available if requested at time of booking. Please contact us if you have any other specific access requirements in this respect.

Facilities at all cottages

The National Trust aims to expand the list of accessible /equipment/items available at each cottage and these may include.

- Hollowfibre bedding
- Chair with armrests
- Good reading light
- Large handle vegetable peeler
- Easy tin opener
- Non-slip mat for bath/shower
