Introduction

Nestled between steep cliffs rich in wildlife, the calm turquoise sea of the cove often gives way to powerful storms, as it faces into the full force of the Atlantic.

Points to note

- Mobile phone reception is patchy across the site.
- There is no visitor reception building.
- There are seasonal welcome team staff on site.
- There is no mobility vehicle for hire.
- Toilet facilities are seasonal and located off the main road towards the cove.
- The car park, toilets & café are not National Trust.

Arrival and parking facilities

- Mullion Cove is approximately 8 miles south of Helston.
- From Helston take the A3083 south towards The Lizard. At Mullion Holiday Park turn right onto the B3296 towards Mullion. Drive through the village and follow signs to Mullion Cove/Harbour.
- The car park is owned by Cornwall Council. Parking charges apply to NT members.
- The car park is hard packed natural stone surface with lots of pot holes.
- There are no disabled parking bays.

Access to Mullion Cove

- From the car park, follow the main road on foot towards the Cove for approximately half a mile.
- There is a pavement for a short distance from the car park, otherwise walking is along the main road.
- The road is on a steady downward slope.
