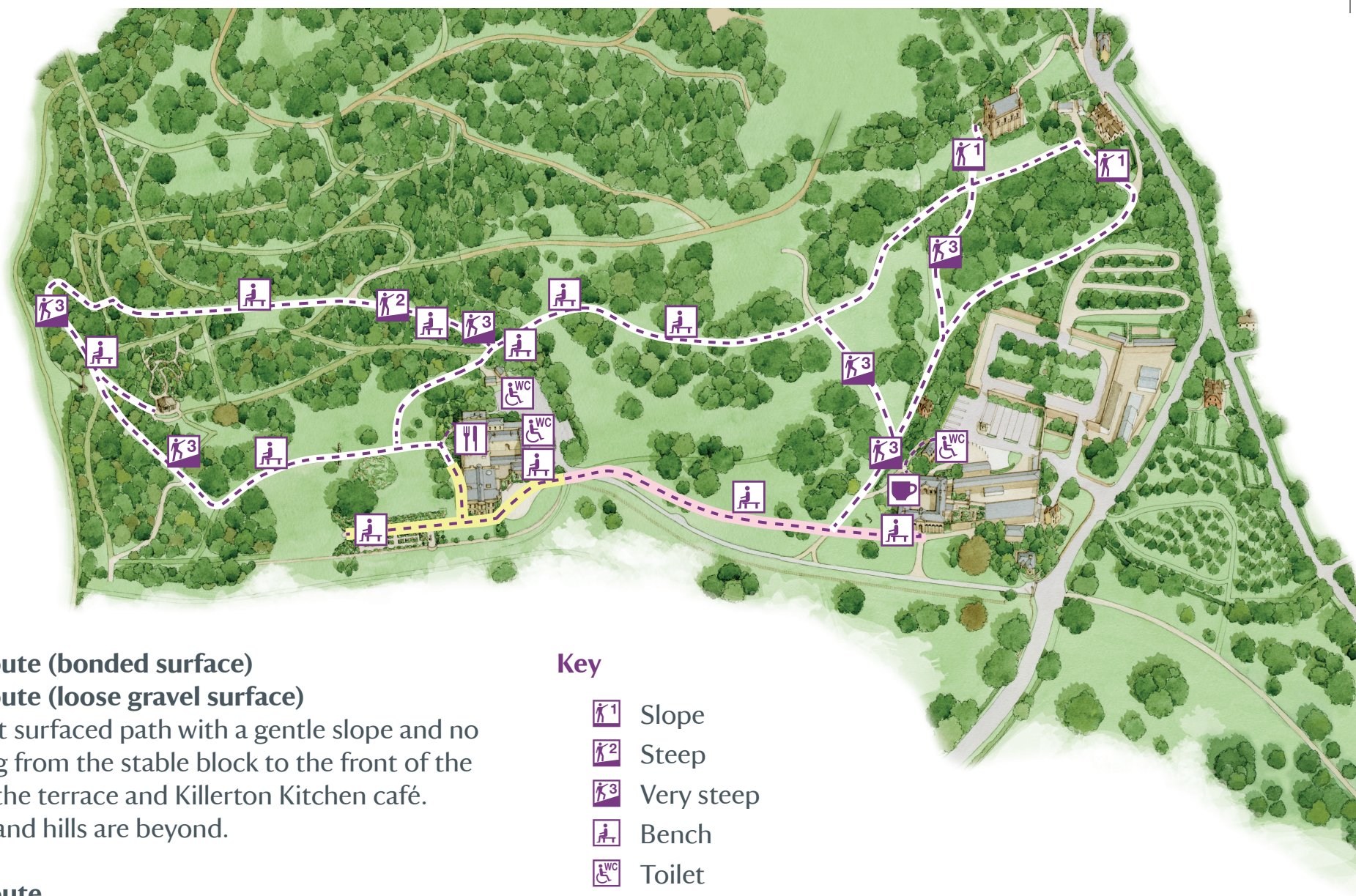

Accessible flat surfaced path with a gentle slope and no steps. Leading from the stable block to the front of the house, on to the terrace and Killerton Kitchen café. Gravel paths and hills are beyond.

Has no steps but significant hills and slopes. Paths are constructed of loose gravel.
