Introduction

A gentle coastal landscape west of Dartmouth with wonderful views, wild flowers and the ruins of a Civil War encampment. Dogs are welcome but must be kept under close control at all times due to livestock grazing.

NB - Mobile phone reception is sporadic across the site, however in an emergency any mobile phone can be used as it will pick up any available signal.

Arrival & Parking Facilities

There are brown signs directing visitors from the B3205. The car park is situated both sides of a farm track. One side is tarmacked and the other is stone surfaced. In the tarmacked car park there are 2 designated Blue Badge Holder parking spaces. The cost to park is £3, or free for National Trust members. To pay, PayByPhone is available or we ask members to leave their membership on their dash, image side up.

There is an orientation panel providing more information about the area. There is no seating in the car park area.

WCs

There are no public toilets on site. The nearest ones are at opposite Dartmouth Castle.

Catering

There are no catering facilities on site.

Walks

The walking track leading from the car park down to the South West Coast Path is stone surfaced and suitable for easier access. Please note it is a steep gradient down to the coast path where there is a picnic bench and viewpoint.
