

## Plymbridge Woods Access Statement

### Points to note:

1. Plymbridge has 197 acres of woodland with paths, uneven ground & hills.
2. The main path is accessible and is part of route 27 [National Cycle Network](#).
3. Mobile phone services across the site are patchy. In the case of an emergency please call 999. For staff assistance please call 01752 341377.
4. Dogs do not have to be kept on leads and dog waste bins are available across the site.
5. There is no parking fee or admission.

### Arrival & Parking Facilities

1. There are no brown signs for the site. The postcode for your sat nav is PL7 4SR and the grid reference is SX 5239 5862.

There are multiple pedestrian access points.

2. There is no allocated disabled parking and there are approximately 100 parking spaces.
3. The car park is laid hard core but does have potholes.
4. There are no wheelchairs or powered mobility vehicles provided.
5. There are no toilets at this site.



## Route 27 & other paths/trails

1. Route 27 is part of the [National Cycle Network](#). The entrance to route 27 is adjacent to the car park. The path surface is laid hard core.
2. Other paths/trails are soil or grass. They have uneven ground and feature some steep inclines. They are not suitable for wheelchairs or mobility scooters.
3. There are interpretation panels located at key points.
4. There are a number of seats throughout the site.



## Other hazards

1. The main path (route 27) is a shared path for cyclists & walkers
2. The site is cleaned regularly but please note that rubbish or dog mess is sometimes discarded and you should be advised to take care
3. There are a number of small ponds, a canal & a river running through the site. Dogs / people should not enter the river when in spate (high water levels)
4. There are a number of quarries on site
5. Do not dwell under large trees in adverse weather conditions
