Introduction

Set within the Kent Downs Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty, One Tree Hill is also recognised nationally as a Site of Special Scientific Interest as a home to rare species of plants, insects and molluscs. The tranquil site has a network of paths, which wind their way up through the woodland. Once at the top, visitors can relax and take in the wonderful view to the south over the Weald of Kent.

All dogs are welcome, including Assistance Dogs.

There is no entrance fee and the site is unmanned.

NB - Mobile phone reception is not very good across the site. In an emergency, please make contact on the phone number above as soon as you are able.

Arrival & Parking Facilities

The car park is signposted from Carter's Hill. It is unsurfaced and there is space for 20 cars. Parking is free. There is an information board in the car park.

The footpaths around the woodland are unpaved and uneven. The ground can be slippery if the weather is wet and is often covered by fallen leaves. The paths are not suitable for wheelchair or buggy users. There is an incline to the top of One Tree Hill, where there is a slab bench (without back or arm rests) for visitors to sit.

There are no refreshment or toilet facilities available on site.
