Orchard Gallery ①
Please ask a member of the team for access to a step-free route. The entrance to Orchard Gallery is quite narrow with a limited turning circle.

Bookshop ②
The second-hand bookshop entrance has a shallow ramp. Please ask a member of the team for assistance if you need help with access.

Level Access at Gunby Estate, Hall and Gardens

Gardens

There are no changes in height in the gardens. Paths are a mixture of grass, gravel and flagstones. Please walk or wheel on the lawns if it's easier for you. We have handy ramps that you can use – just ask a member of the team.

Benches

There are plenty of places to pause in the garden. Some benches may need to move from time to time for maintenance or to give the grass a rest.



House

There are steps to the house entrance and exit. The steps by the side door are easier to use for some visitors.

The basement and first floor are accessed by stairs that have a handrail to one side.

Please ask a member of the team for assistance if you'd like to use Gunby's wheelchair or walker in the house.





Wheelchair and mobility scooter
