Carpark

You will arrive in the car park. You can find spaces for blue badge holders on the right if you need one.

There is a vehicle that can give you assistance to and from the car park if you need it. Call the number displayed in the panel at the carpark.





Visitor Services

Here you will meet our Visitor Services team. They will be wearing blue t-shirts and dark blue fleeces.

This is where you can purchase your ticket for the Alice in Wonderland Easter trail.

When you have purchased your ticket for the trail, you will be given an orange token.

Please note: we have a limited number of easter eggs per day.





Stableyard

Give the token to the staff at the gazebo to get your trail sheet and bunny ears.

Staff will be wearing blue t-shirts and dark blue fleeces.

This place can get noisy during busy times. Other visitors may be running, jumping or shouting as they play.



The trail

To start the trail, go through the hedge behind the green van.

This path is uneven and can sometimes get muddy.



The paths around the trail are across grass, loose gravel, and woodchip.
Some paths may be uneven.

Trail points are around the gardens. Follow the arrows to continue the trail.

There are some activities to do around the trail, and some things to look at.





After the tunnels follow the arrow up the steps to the next trail point.

For a step free route:

- You can go back through the hedge, turn right and go into the gardens using the slope. Please note this path is uneven and can sometimes get muddy.
- You can get into the gardens using the gate to the right of the Hall.
 Please ask a member of staff for assistance.





The grass path to the Boathouse can sometimes get muddy, making this trail point difficult to get to.

If you cannot get to the Boathouse, you can do the nature mural activity in the Activity Hub. This is in the Stableyard.





The path behind the Boathouse can sometimes get muddy, making this trail point difficult to get to.

If you cannot get to this place, you can do this activity in the Activity Hub. This is in the Stableyard.

Can you find the 2 caterpillars on the table?





The path to the play area sometimes gets muddy, making this trail point difficult to get to.

If you cannot get to the play area, you can do this activity in the in the Stableyard.

Can you find all the eggs in the trees?



When you have completed the trail, go to the gazebo in the Stableyard.

The staff will stamp your trail sheet and you will get x1 chocolate egg.
