## Buggy Service

A free shuttle service is available from Visitor Reception to the Mansion (1100m). Pick up stops are marked on the map, and it runs from 9.30am, approximately every 30 minutes until 30 minutes before closing time One of our shuttle buggies is accessible for wheelchair users.

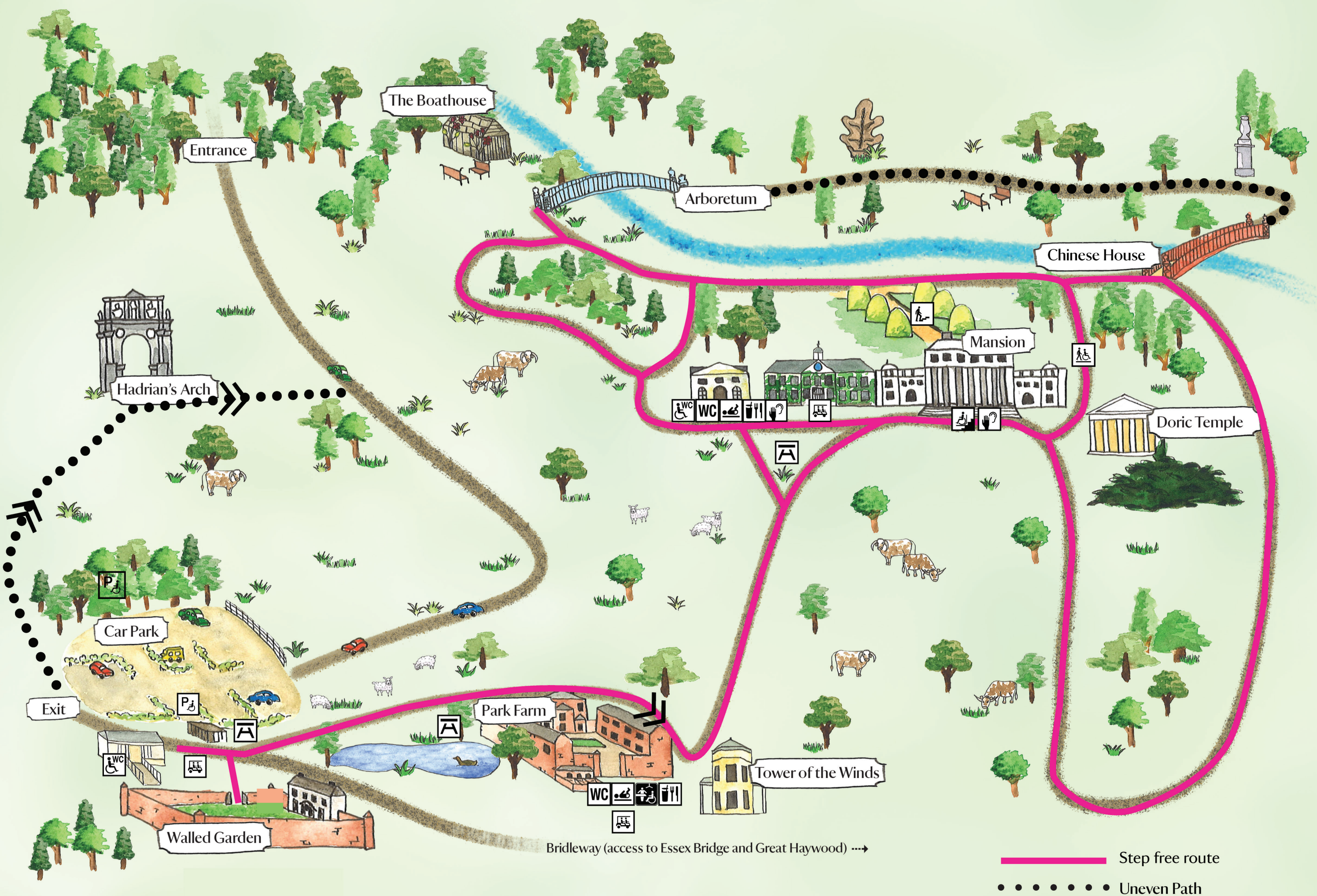
## Mobility Aids

Visitors can borrow a multi-terrain powered mobility vehicle (Tramper). We recommend booking these in advance.

Manual wheelchairs are also available to borrow from the Visitor Reception, the Bookshop, Mansion and Servants Quarters.

## Indoor Areas

The toilets, cafe's, Zen Den and shops have step free access. The Servants Quarters are largely wheelchair accessible with the exception of the wet laundry room. The Mansion is accessed via 7 steps. There is no handrail. We have a stair climbing lift to give access to a wheelchair user. The upper floor of the Lichfield Apartment can only be accessed via a staircase. There is seating available inside the mansion and you can pick up a 'What to expect' map and sensory support items at the entrance.



## Paths & Seating

The main paths are relatively flat and step free. The more uneven Arboretum path and the steps at the Mansion terraces are marked on the map. Wider estate paths, are uneven trail paths; our Trampers can manage most. There are benches or seating spaces approximately every 100m, except in the Arboretum.

## Toilets & Changing Place

We have accessible toilets near the Visitor Reception and the Mansion Tea Room. There is a Changing Places facility at Park Farm. RADAR keys are required to access the Visitor Welcome Accessible toilet and the Changing Place. If you don't have a RADAR Key, you can borrow one from Visitor Welcome, the Park Farm Cafe or the Gift shop.

## The Zen Den

We have a dedicated quiet room called 'The Zen Den'. This is a calming space, providing a safe and secure environment to help people reduce stress, self regulate and calm their senses. The Zen Den can be found near the buggy stop by the Mansion.
