### **Introduction**

Completed in 1293, this medieval house includes a Great Hall, 15<sup>th</sup> century kitchen and an unusual wall painting.

This is a private home and visitors are shown around by the tenants/volunteers.

Assistance dogs only are welcome.

Mobile reception is good. If you encounter any difficulties, please call the office number above. In case of an emergency call 999.

### **Arrival & Parking Facilities**

There are no brown signs to Treasurer's House.

Parking can be found on the road nearby. There is no designated parking for disabled visitors. There is an uneven paved pathway to the house entrance.

### **WCs**

There are no toilet facilities on site.

### **Visitor Reception**

There are no visitor reception facilities.

### **House**

The pathway to the house from the road is approx. 100 yards and is unevenly paved. There are steps, no ramped access.

The entrance doorway is manual, stepped and 86cm wide.

There are no wheelchairs available for loan. There is no induction loop.

Rooms do not contain soft furnishings.

All house doorways are wider than 750mm.

Light levels are quite good, with some natural and some artificial light.

Access to the first floor is by narrow stairs with handrail.

There are some seats around the house for visitors to use.

There is a short guide available to borrow. The tenants will give a tour/answer questions.
