The National Trust car park is approx. 300m from the stone circle and 500m from the facilities in the Old Farmyard.

Blue Badge holders can park in the High Street car park.

Terrain

There are gravel paths and areas of cobblestones in the Old Farmyard. There are gates into the henge monument.

The henge and avenue consist of uneven ground, occasional mud, tufty grass, slippery chalk, and are shared with our conservation grazers (sheep and cattle) who leave their own special environmental deposits.

Please take care crossing the busy roads.
