Introduction

- The cottage is located in its own grounds with a river and views of Llanerchaeron House.
- Parking for vehicles.
- This property is wheelchair accessible (bedroom and bathroom on ground floor).
- The cottage is located at Llanerchaeron and is a self-catering cottage accommodating up to six people. Accommodation is all situated on two floors: there are three bedroom (ground floor has a twin bedroom and the 1st floor has a double and a twin) and two bathrooms (one on the ground floor with wheelchair access and one on the 1st floor).
- It has a wood-burning stove.
- It has sloping ceilings on the first floor.

Pre-Arrival

- Please bring a torch if arriving in dark, as there are no streetlights.



Approach

From the East: Travel along the A482 past the brown road sign for Llanerchaeron and continue along the A482 for approximately a mile when you will see a turning on the right-hand side of the road that has a sharp turning. Take this turning and continue down this road over a small bridge and you will see Abermydyr on you left hand side.

From the West: When in Aberaeron turn onto the A482 and continue for approx. 2 miles on your left you will see a turning. Take this turning and continue down this road over a small bridge and you will see Abermydyr on you left hand side.

Arrival & Parking Facilities

Once at Abermydyr, park at the front of the property. The key safe is located around the left-hand side of the property in the doorway to the kitchen. Access to the property is via the door with a small step at the front of the property. The pathway down to the front door is cobbled and slightly uneven.

Getting in (and out) of the cottage

• The front door has a clear opening width of 800mm.



• The side door goes straight into the downstairs bedroom has a clear opening width of 800mm.



• The kitchen door has a clear opening width of 820mm.



- The living/dining room door has a clear opening width of 800mm with two small steps (100mm and 50mm).
- The property is on two floors.

Getting around the cottage

Ground Floor

• The floors are wooden in the living/dining room and reading area, tiled in the kitchen and downstairs bathroom and tile effect lino in the bedroom. The living room has a rug.

Reading Room

- Doorway into kitchen is 760mm wide.
- Doorway into living/dining room is 820mm wide.
- Doorway into bedroom is 750mm wide.
- Two armchairs, seat height 500mm.
- Freezer.
- Small coffee table.
- Wall lights.

Living/Dining Room

- Two 3-seater sofas, seat height 480mm.
- TV/DVD.
- Wood burning stove.
- Two freestanding lamps and ceiling lights.
- Wooden trunk used as coffee table.
- Wooden dresser.
- Wooden round dining table and six wooden upright dining chairs (two have arms).
- Table is 750mm high with a clear knee space of 720mm all round.
- Chairs have a seat height of 460mm.



Bedroom 1 (ground floor)

- Ramp leading from reading room into the bedroom.
- L-shaped room.
- Two twin beds.
- Bed height 700mm.
- One chair with reading light, chair seat height is 450mm.
- One chest of drawers with reading light.
- Wooden wardrobe.
- Ceiling lights.
- Runner rug in centre of room.
- Door into bathroom 730mm wide.

Bathroom 1 (ground floor)

- Ground floor bathroom is a wet room.
- WC, sink, open shower.
- WC seat height is 420mm.
- Sink has pillar taps.
- Open shower mixer tap and a shower seat, seat height is 520mm.
- Heated towel rail.
- Safety handles in shower area and around WC.





- Kitchen
 - Ramp down into kitchen.
 - Slate worktop 910mm high.
 - Belfast sink 870mm high to rim with pillar taps.
 - Electric cooker with hob.
 - Fridge, cordless kettle, toaster, microwave, washing machine.
 - Ceiling lights.
 - Curved wooden stairs leading to 1st floor.
 - Step up to upstairs hallway (140mm).



Bedroom 2 (end of balcony)

- Door into bedroom is 720mm wide.
- Sloping ceilings.
- Two twin beds.
- Bed height 700mm.
- One bedside cabinet with reading light.
- One chest of drawers.
- One wooden straight back chair, seat height is 460mm.
- Children's school desk with built in seat.
- Ceiling lights.
- Rug between the beds.

Bathroom 2


- Door into bathroom 590mm wide.
- WC, sink, bath with overhead shower.
- WC seat height is 420mm.
- Sink has pillar taps.
- Bath has pillar taps and shower has mixer taps.





Bedroom 3

- Two steps into bedroom (both are 220mm high).
- Door into bedroom is 720mm wide.
- Sloping ceilings.
- Double bed.
- Bed height 770mm.
- Two bedside cabinets with reading lights.
- One dressing table.
- One wooden rocking chair, seat height is 410mm.
- Ceiling lights.
- Rug at end of bed.



Garden

- Set in its own grounds with a river running on two sides of the property.
- Wooden table and chairs.
- Washing line.

Additional Information

Central heating from oil.



- Wood-burning stove in living/dining room
- Assistance and pet dogs are welcome at this cottage
- In the event of a fire, it is the responsibility of the guests to evacuate the building themselves. Please contact us if you have any specific access requirements in this respect.

Facilities at all cottages
