

## Crom Stone Pods Accessibility Guide (2026)

### Introduction

- Crom Stone Pods are located on the National Trust Crom Estate and are accessed via the Estate entrance.
- Accommodation offered consists of five glamping pods.
- The site facilities consist of a reception, tearoom, toilet and shower block with external washing up area for dishes. There is also a communal fire pit.
- Mobile phone reception is limited, and you are often roaming due to being close to the border with the Republic of Ireland. There is National Trust free Wi-Fi on site within the Reception area and Visitor Centre.
- Dogs are welcome in three of the five Pods, maximum two per Pod.
- Lots of information is available on our website.

### Arrival & Parking Facilities

- Crom Stone Pods are situated 7 miles from Lisnaskea off the A34.
- Crom Estate is well signposted via the brown tourist road signs.
- The main gates to the Estate will be open during the Estate opening times which can be found on the National Trust website. At all other times, a coded keypad on the right-hand side of the gate post will provide access. All guests to the campsite will be provided with the code on arrival unless they are arriving outside of the opening times when it will be given to them beforehand. The height of the keypad is 1600mm high.
- The avenue into the campsite is tarmac with three speed bumps measuring 50mm high. There is also a cattle grid.
- The car park is stoned and is slightly sloped.



## Reception

- The reception is located along a paved path at the bottom of the car park.
- The reception doorway is 870mm wide.
- The desk is 850mm high.
- There is a hearing loop system installed in the reception.
- Staff will provide assistance if required.



## Public Areas - General

- The Pods are located below the main Visitor Centre building and are part of the buildings structure as opposed to your typical Pod structure.
- The main avenue is tarmac which turns into stone when entering the car park. The shower block has level paving slabs around it and the path to the Pods is level paving slabs with concrete level ground outside the Pods.
- The trails around the National Trust Property Estate are of varying terrain and suitable for various abilities of accessibility.
- There is a communal fire pit located next to one of the pitching areas. There are four logs for seating next to the fire and some picnic benches.

## Public Areas – Toilet and Shower Block

The site has one toilet and shower block which has a paved path area around it and into each access doorway.

The toilets are internally lit with sensor lights which turn on when the main door to the toilet facilities open.

- All facilities have hot water throughout and underfloor heating.
- On the gable end wall there is a stainless steel washing up sink with two bowls and push hot and cold taps. The sink is 950mm high from the ground and is covered over with a tiled roof structure.

## Ladies Toilets

- The ladies' facilities consist of 3 toilets, 3 wash hand basins and 2 showers. There is also a hand dryer available.
- The access doorway to the ladies' facilities is 950mm wide and opens inwards with a push handle.
- The wash hand basin is 850mm high.
- The toilet cubicle door is 740mm wide.
- The toilet is 430mm high.
- The showers cubicle doors are 740mm wide and the door opens inwards with the handle at 1200mm high.
- Shower unit controls are 1280mm high.
- There are no handrails and no seat within the shower.

## Men's Toilets

- The men's facilities consist of 2 toilets, 2 urinals, 3 wash hand basins and 2 showers.
- The access doorway is 950mm wide and opens inwards with a push handle.
- The wash hand basin is 850mm high.
- The toilet cubicle door is 750mm wide.
- The toilet is 430mm high.

- The shower cubicle door is 730mm wide and the door opens inwards with the handle at 1000mm high.
- Shower unit controls are 1200mm high.
- There are no handrails and no seat within the shower.

## Accessible Toilet

- There is a separate private accessible washroom which is 3200mm x 2600mm.
- The access door is 950mm wide and opens inwards with the handle at 1040mm high.
- The toilet is 480mm high and has a fixed handrail on the right hand side and a drop down hand rail to the left hand side.
- The sink is 720mm high.
- There is 1 shower.
- There is a glass panel at the shower with an opening to access the shower at 1210mm wide.
- The shower units' controls are 900mm high, there is one handrail to the right hand side of the shower and one fixed seat.



## Laundry Area

- The laundry area is a shared facility with the National Trust Holiday Cottage guests.
- It is located within the Holiday Cottage courtyard and the entrance is via paved pathway with a step into the room.
- There is an 80mm step into the laundry room, an outside door 850mm wide and inside door 700mm wide.
- There is one undercounter freezer for storing of ice packs only.
- There is one front loading tumble dryer. The dryer is token operated, the tokens can be purchased from the Visitor Centre. Visitor Centre Opening Hours can be found on the National Trust Property Website
- The tumble dryer door handle is 600mm high from the ground.

- There is also a payphone located within this area. Door access to the payphone is 720mm wide.

## Recycling Centre

- The Recycling Centre is located in part of the barn in the main car park. It is concrete level flooring inside the barn with the car park stone around.
- There is a mixture and various sizes of general waste, recycling, food waste and glass bottle bins all with lift top lids.

## Pods

- There are five Pods located below the Visitor Centre building on a level concrete surface with small amount of stones either side of the Pod and a grass area opposite.
- Each of the Pods sleeps a maximum of 2 adults and 3 children.
- There is a small threshold step into the Pods, measuring 40mm high.
- The door to the Pod is 820mm wide.
- The Pod measures 5000mm x 3350mm internally.
- The Pod internally consists of
  - vinyl flooring with a ceiling light
  - table lamp
  - oil free heater on a time clock
  - 8 plugs and 4 USB sockets
  - a boot rack
  - small bin
  - wall mirror
  - blinds for the windows
  - kettle
  - microwave
  - tabletop fridge
  - Kitchen appliances are within a fitted kitchen unit with the worktop measuring 920mm high
  - (Dog-friendly Pods Wilbur and Napoleon) Two single wooden frame beds with waterproof mattresses measuring 500mm high x 1910mm length x 910mm wide
  - (Non-dog friendly Pods Perky and Pinky, Dog Friendly Pod Empress) Zip and link divan single beds with mattresses and mattress protector measuring 620mm high x 1900mm length x 920mm wide
- There are also two foldable wooden chairs and a table provided with each Pod, chairs measuring 450mm high and table 730mm high.
- Each Pod is provided with a wooden picnic table with BBQ grill which is located outside the Pod. The seating on each table measures 460mm high and the table itself is 760mm high.
- Cars can be brought down to the pods only for offloading and onloading purposes. Cars must be parked in the main car park for the duration of your stay.
