Introduction

- The cottage accommodates 3 people
- Electric panel central heating.
- Bathroom room with Shower
- Fully equipped kitchen
- Open plan lounge, kitchen, diner.
- Parking available for two cars
- No dogs permitted at the property

Cottage is arranged as follows:

Ground floor

Open plan Sitting room, Kitchen, Dining area.



On Landing

• Fully fitted Bathroom with shower over bath, wash hand basin and wc.

First floor

Single and Double master Bedroom.

Pre-Arrival

- See the main webpage for booking and location details.
- Please contact us prior to booking if you have any specific access requirements.
- Directions provided with booking
- Bring torch if arriving in the dark as there are no streetlights here.

Approach

 Access to this cottage/Pod is via the Beddgelert entrance to Craflwyn Hall. Follow a long drive, keeping left at the fork to the Hall, carry on through the White gate and the cottage is on the immediate left. Once unloaded the car will have to be parked back down in the car park near the entrance gate.

Arrival & Parking Facilities

- The key to your cottage will be in a key safe at the right hand side entry door. The
 combination will need to be entered to open the key safe (the buttons must click when
 pushed). To close the key safe the procedure needs to be reversed.
- Once you have unloaded your car it will need to be parked back down the drive in the car park as access is required to the farmland beyond.
- The Hall gardens and pasture have footpaths running as far as Snowdon and you're free to roam those as much as you wish. Just remember it is a farming area and there is livestock around so keep your dog on a lead and keep the area clean.





Getting in (and out) of the cottage

- The side door step is 4cm high up into the cottage
- The front door has a clear opening width of 85cm.
- The front door has two steps one of 15cm and one of 10cm then a further step up into the living area of 24cm.





Getting around the cottage

Ground floor:

- Level access from front door through sitting area to dining and kitchen.
- The settee and chairs in the lounge area are of a seat height of 47cm.
- The dining table is 75cm high and the dining chairs are 45cm to seat level.
- In the kitchen the work tops are 94cm high with the cooker being 90cm high.
- The ground floor is tiled with a rug in the seating area.
- The stairs are through a door that when open measures 76cm.

Landing level:

- The bathroom is well fitted, containing a bath at a height of 54cm with electric shower over.
- A wc which is 40cm high
- Wash hand basin that is 79cm high.





First floor:

- At the top of the stairs on the right is a single bedroom with a bed that is 60cm to the top
 of the mattress.
- In front of you is the double bedroom which contains a bed whose height is 65cm.
- The double bedroom also contains a chair at 45cm high, and a dresser whose top measures 75cm high.



Sitting Room

- One sofa
- Two armchairs
- Large rug with non-slip backing covering floor between furniture
- Log Burner

Dining Area

- One Table
- Four chairs



Kitchen

- Washing Machine
- Dryer
- Electric cooker
- Microwave
- Fridge Freezer

Bathroom

- Bath
- Mira shower
- Wash hand basin
- WC

No separate WC

Single Bedroom

- Single Bed
- Set of Drawers
- Bedside Lamp.



Double Bedroom

- Double bed
- Set of Drawers
- Bedside cabinets
- Bedside Lamps
- Dressing table and mirror.

Additional Information

- Assistance dogs are welcome at all our cottages.
- No dogs can be accommodated here.
- In the event of a fire, it is the responsibility of the guests to evacuate themselves. Vibrating fire/smoke detectors are available if requested at time of booking. Please contact us if you have any other specific access requirements in this respect.
