

National Trust Cottages Accessibility Guide

Garden Cottage (006019) Croft Castle Herefordshire HR6 9PW



Introduction

- This Gothic style Cottage is located within its own walled garden within the estate of Croft Castle. Guests have access to beautiful views and excellent walks in the surrounding countryside.
- The cottage is connected up to the main properties biomass boiler system for hot water and heating and accommodates 6 + travel cot. The house has a private garden at the back, and direct access to the walled garden at the front.
- Due to changes of level on the approach and a narrow entrance at the entry point this cottage may not be suitable for wheelchair users.

The Cottage is arranged as follows:

Ground Floor: porch, kitchen/dining area, sitting room, bathroom and separate shower, single bed-room.

First Floor: Three bedrooms, 1 double with 5ft bed, 1 twin and 1 single and a separate lavatory

- Arrival in daylight is highly recommended

Approach

Unmade estate access road. Very little traffic.

Arrival & Parking Facilities

- Arrival is down Croft Castle's main drive. The access road through to the tea room is tarmac, and then the road is unmade from here on. You pass through a working farm; therefore the lane can be muddy, particularly in bad weather. There is also two gates to open and close to get to the cottage.
- Parking space is located just outside the garden fence of the cottage (25m to front door)
- The small wooden gate is signed 'Garden Cottage' Width of the gate is 830mm.
- 3 irregular height steps along the route of the path range170 230mm. Handrail is provided.

 Further 4 irregular height concrete steps at the end of the path. 180 -210mm. A handrail is provided.





Getting in (and out) of the cottage

- Formal front door to the Cottage is located at the front of the house which opens into the gardens of the Castle. 2 steps of 200mm.
- Secondary entrance with large porch (2100 x 1400mm) with threshold of 70mm. Porch contains a plumbed in washing machine. This is the entrance that guests use.
- Door width 790mm inward opening door. Coir mat.
- Threshold down into kitchen of 50mm.
- Front door clear width is 960mm and leads into the Hall







Getting around the cottage

Ground floor:

- Door from Hall into kitchen is 850mm.
- Leads to Sitting Room and Kitchen. Good circulation space
- No inter-room changes in level or thresholds
- Corridor width <900mm

Stairs to first floor -13 risers at 190mm. There is a banister/handrail to one side at 900mm and carpeted stairs. This area is well lit.

First floor:

- 3 bedrooms
- Separate WC
- No inter-room changes in level or thresholds.

Kitchen/Diner



- Height of worktop is 900mm
- Large pine kitchen table at 760mm. Small fascia under.
- Marmoleum floor covering
- Good circulation
- Electric oven and hob. Drop-down door. Hob has controls to the front with clear numerals.
- Fridge/Freezer, washing machine and dish-washer.
- Good natural light. Spot-lights and hob-light

Ground floor Bathroom and Shower- room 2800 x 2350mm

- Very large room with WC, basin & bath with shower attachment on taps
- Bath 550mm high. Straight bath no moulding.
 Integral hand-grips. Pillar cross-taps. Reasonable circulation around the bath.
- Sink at 800mm. Pillar taps
- The WC is 430mm high. Close coupled unit.
- Flush-floor shower cubicle 800 x 880mm. Mira shower at 1500mm to centre. 1400mm to riser bar.





- Heated towel rail.
- Wall mounted heater
- Good illumination levels

Single Bedroom Ground Floor

- Divan bed with height to top of 570mm
- Bed-site light (low energy bulb)
- Reasonable circulation space next to the bed.





Sitting Room

- 2 x 2-seater sofa with straight arms at 460mm to seat
- 2 x wing arm-chairs with straight arms at 470mm to seat
- Good levels of illumination large windows
- Table and standard lamps (Low energy)
- Good circulation space
- Carpeted (close weave)

Twin Bedroom First Floor

- Divan beds 600mm to top 2m (L)
- Bed-side lights to each side (Low energy bulbs)
- Good illumination.
- Bed-room seat
- Carpet
- Good visual contrast between furniture and walls





Double Bedroom First Floor

- Metal frame bed at 540mm to top of bed 2m (L)
- Bed-side lights (Low energy bulbs)
- Full length mirror
- 2 bedroom chairs
- Carpet

Single Bedroom First Floor

- Single divan bed at 550mm high 1.9m(L)
- Bedside light (Low energy bulbs)
- Mirror
- Carpet





Lavatory on first floor

- Standard WC, close coupled and height of 420mm.
- Small sink with cross-taps

Garden

• Slightly sloping site. Mostly lawn with shrubs and trees and some borders. Enclosed but easy access to nearby parkland. Garden furniture available.

Garden table with a height of 740mm and six chairs with a seat height of 460mm.







Additional Information

- Assistance dogs are welcome at all our cottages
- In the event of a fire, it is the responsibility of the guests to evacuate themselves. Vibrating fire/smoke detectors are available if requested at time of booking. Please contact us if you have any other specific access requirements in this respect.



Facilities at all cottages
