Introduction

The largest of three delightful cottages, which fronts onto a minor road, close to Fountains Abbey. There is use of a shared garden across the road.

The Cottage is arranged as follows:

Ground Floor:

Kitchen, dining room, sitting room, rear lobby, utility room and shower room

First Floor:

• Bathroom, two double bedrooms and a twin bedroom

Second Floor

Double/Twin bedroom and games/TV room

Approach

The cottage is situated by a minor road and the West Gate entrance to Fountains Abbey

Arrival & Parking Facilities

• There is parking for one car in the garage and also a car park across the road.

Getting in (and out) of the cottage

From the garage there is an uneven stone step up 20mm to the rear of the property. The entrance door to be used is the rear door to the kitchen. The front door on the road is not in use.







Getting around the cottage

· The cottage has carpets in most rooms and there is also tiling and cushion flooring

Rear entrance door into kitchen



• Back door opens to 800mm wide and with a 20mm threshold

Kitchen



- Height of worktop is 910mm
- Electric cooker and hob
- Fridge freezer and dishwasher
- Microwave, toaster and kettle



Door to inner hall is 750mm with a 70mm step up







Sitting Room

- Door opens to 750mm with a 3mm step down
- Table 790mm and chairs 450mm high
- 1xTable lights on side table with Radio/CD Player. Dresser. Single Chair.

Dining Room

- The door opens to 750mm with a 3mm step down
- Three sofas and a chair at 440mm high
- Another arm chair is 460mm high
- Wood burning stove and Combined TV/DVD on wall
- Coffee table 370mm high
- 2x Standard lamps



- Hall door opens to 710mm wide and has a 30mm step up
- Door to lobby 710mm
- Coat rack and chair 440mm high

Utility room

- Door opens to 710mm
- Washing machine, tumble drier and small chest freezer

Ground Floor Shower Room





- Door opens to 710mm
- WC is 470mm with grab rail to side
- Basin 770mm high with lever taps
- Shower door is 460mm wide
- There is a step in to the shower 140mm high and a grab rail

Stairs

Thirteen steps at 20mm with hand rail to left hand side

Twin Bedroom front



- Door opens to 700mm wide
- Two single beds 660mm high
- One bedside table and two side lights
- Wardrobe and chest of drawers
- One chair 400mm high
- Wash hand basin 760mm high



Double Bedroom back



- Door opens to 700mm wide
- Bed is 680mm high
- One bedside table and side light
- Wardrobe and chest of drawers
- One chairs 350mm high

Double bedroom front



- Door opens to 670mm wide
- Bed Is 620mm high
- Two bedside tables and two side lights
- Wardrobe and two chest of drawers
- One chair 330mm high
- Wash hand basin 780mm high

Bathroom



- Door opens to 740mm wide
- Wash hand basin is 780mm high
- WC is 450mm high
- The shower cubicle has a 170mm step in
- The bath is 540mm high and has grab handles



Stairs to second floor

Eleven steps at 20mm with hand rail to left hand side

Second floor bedroom




- Door opens to 800mm wide
- Beds are 660mm high
- Two bedside tables and lights
- Wardrobe, Dressing table and chest of drawers
- Two chairs 400mm high

Games room

- Door opens to 770mm wide
- One sofa and a chair 460mm high
- TV/DVD and coffee table
