

National Trust Cottages Accessibility Guide

Ickworth Keeper's Cottage, Ickworth, IP29 5QE

Cottage ref. 010051

Introduction

- Keeper's Cottage is a two-storey semi-detached Victorian brick and slate cottage
- Sleeps eight in four bedrooms
- One upstairs bathroom with bath and separate shower cubicle; one ensuite shower room, one downstairs cloakroom
- Open fire in sitting room
- Garden to west; another garden to the north and east of the cottage, partly shaded by woods



* Please note that all door widths given indicate the clearance required for access

The cottage is arranged as follows:

Ground Floor:

 L-shaped hall leading to main sitting room, ground floor (king size bedded) room, cloakroom, utility and kitchen-diner

First Floor:

- Stairs with two 90 degree turns
- Landing leading to king size, twin and super-king size bedrooms (can be a twin on request)
- En-suite shower room off super-king size bedroom
- Bathroom with bath & separate shower cubicle

Pre-Arrival

- Please bring a torch if arriving in the dark as there are no streetlights here

Approach

- A road leading to a track (both with some potholes) leads through the estate to the cottage
- The cottage sits by a green around which are dotted a few other tenanted cottages and the rangers' office and workshop
- There is a pond nearby



Arrival & Parking Facilities

- There is a gravel parking area at the end of the cottage's garden with a concrete path bordering the exterior of the garden wall
- A gate (1070mm wide) opens onto a gently upwards sloping concrete path 910mm wide
- The 23m long path leading to the porch within the rear walled garden is cracked and uneven
- The illuminated dial keysafe is to the right of the entrance door within the porch

Getting in (and out) of the cottage

- The main entrance door is 850mm wide with a 95mm threshold
- Opens onto an L-shaped hall

Getting around the cottage

Entrance Hall:

- 825mm at its narrowest
- Carpeted plus two rugs and entrance matwell

Sitting room

Sitting room:

- Door 700mm wide
- Two three-seater sofas with seat height of 450mm
- A two-seater sofa and two armchairs with seat height of 470mm
- Television upon a table 650mm high
- Open fire with mirror over mantelpiece
- Windows facing west over the side garden, and north and east over the main garden
- Four ceiling lights; two table lamps on side tables 600mm, 700mm and 730mm high
- Three other small side tables 370mm, 530mm and 700mm high
- Two floor standing lamps
- Carpeted plus two rugs

Ground Floor Bedroom:

- Door 920mm wide
- King size divan bed (150cm wide) 650mm high; 250mm space underneath
- 1 two-seater sofa with seat height of 480mm
- Small television (18 inch screen) upon a small chest of drawers 680mm high
- Two bedside cabinets 870mm high
- Bookcase 200mm deep, 1180mm high and a low side table 290mm / Telephone handset
- Wall mirror above bookcase
- Window facing west over the front garden
- Wooden & glazed door to garden 820mm wide with 60mm high stone threshold
- Two ceiling lights; two bedside lamps 400mm high with glass shades
- Carpeted and mat by door to garden

Cloakroom

- Door 850mm wide lino flooring, ceiling light
- Narrowest gap to manoeuvre into the room is 700mm
- Toilet seat height: 410mm
- Basin height: 860mm with Lever taps and mirror over basin
- East-facing frosted window overlooking the main garden

Utility

- Part-glazed door 720mm wide lino flooring, ceiling light
- Worktop height: 920mm
- Sink and draining board with small lever taps
- Washing machine; tumble drier
- Fuse box at high level (2m10)
- East-facing window overlooking the main garden

Kitchen-diner:

- Part-glazed door 720mm wide
- Threshold: level with tiled kitchen-diner; 50mm higher than carpeted hall
- Fitted units at ground and eye-level
- Dishwasher, fridge-freezer, electric hob, oven, microwave, toaster, kettle & CD player / radio
- Worktop height is 920mm
- Double sink and draining board; taps with small levers
- Wooden dining table is 750mm high with clear knee space of 620mm
- Eight wooden dining chairs with cushioned seats; seat height 460mm, back 550mm high from seat – wooden High chair
- Dresser 470mm deep with main surface 920mm high
- Kitchen window overlook main garden (east facing); dining window over main rear garden
- Ceiling light above dining table; strip of spotlights over kitchen

Stairs

Nineteen steps with two gentle 90 degree right-hand turns


- Steps are 180mm high wide treads but narrowing on corners
- Handrail on outer side
- Carpeted

Landing

- Door-less entry to landing 1.78m high carpeted
- Airing cupboard and adjacent cupboard with boiler and heating controls, iron/board and vacuum. Two convector heaters stored within this cupboard



Bathroom

- Door 720mm wide
- Door-less wide entry to shower and toilet area within main bathroom 1.8m high
- Shower cubicle: 110mm threshold; shower tray 20mm higher than floor level; 620mm door width; 800mm minimum internal width / depth
- Toilet seat height: 420mm
- Bath: 580mm high; 530mm internal width between grab-rails; 1500mm internal length
- Sink height: 800mm
- Lever taps
- Non-slip mat
- Wooden chair with cushioned seat; seat height 460mm
- Central light flush to ceiling; further flush ceiling light in shower / toilet area; shaving light above mirror above sink
- East-facing window overlooking the main garden

King Size Bedroom

- Door 720mm wide
- King size divan bed 650mm high; 250mm space underneath
- Two bedside cabinets 790mm high, each with a table lamp, glass shades
- Off-centre ceiling light
- Wooden upholstered chair with cushioned seat; seat height 400mm
- Cupboard / wardrobe 730mm wide
- Mirror-topped chest of drawers 760mm high to surface
- Carpeted
- West-facing window overlooks the side garden and allotment, paddocks further of

Twin Bedroom

- Door 880mm wide; 1.79m high
- Two single divan beds 660mm high; 250mm space under beds
- One bedside cabinet 770mm high with one table lamp
- Central ceiling light
- Mirror-topped chest of drawers 820mm high to surface
- 2 small wooden chairs 450mm seat height
- Cupboard / wardrobe 680mm; another cupboard 420mm wide
- West-facing window overlooks the side garden
- Carpeted



King Twin Super king

Super King Size Bedroom

- Door 880mm wide; 1.79m high
- Two single divans zip linked to 180cm size 670mm high; 250mm space underneath
- Two bedside cupboards 760mm high, each with a table lamp
- Central ceiling light
- 2 wooden chairs with cushioned seats; 460mm seat height
- Cheval mirror
- Mirror-topped chest of drawers 1110mm high to surface
- Walk-in wardrobe/dressing area access 660mm wide hanging rails and ceiling light
- Carpeted
- West-facing window overlooks the side garden

En-suite

- Door 720mm wide
- Shower cubicle: 270mm step up into the cubicle; 720mm door width; 830mm minimum internal width / depth
- Sink height: 800mm
- Lever taps
- Toilet seat height: 420mm
- Central light flush to ceiling; spotlight in shower cubicle; shaving light / mirror above basin
- East-facing window overlooking the main garden

Garden

- Good-sized main garden at rear laid to lawn, entirely enclosed by walls
- Concrete path from parking area to front door rough cast surface, level/slight gradient
- Metal garden table height 760mm; 730mm knee space on paved patio level with lawn height
- 8 metal chairs, seat height 440mm
- Low row of outbuildings, one unlocked for storage cycles etc
- Small front garden with low fence accessed from ground floor bedroom
- Mainly lawn, with a few espaliered trees and shrubs planted by the house and wall to the north
