

# **National Trust Cottages Access Guide**

Mattress Cottage Broadclyst, Devon, EX5 3JL

Reference: 012014



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#### Introduction

- Mattress Cottage is located near the village of Broadclyst, just outside of Exeter. The cottage forms part of a former farmhouse which has been split into three holiday apartments.
- Mattress Cottage has accommodation for five guests in three bedrooms.

#### **Pre-Arrival**

- Please contact us prior to booking if you have any specific access requirements.
- Detailed directions are provided with booking confirmation.
- Please bring a torch if arriving in the dark as there are no street lights at the cottage and a torch is useful to see the key safe combination lock numbers.

#### Approach

- The cottage is located off Mooredge Lane, a quiet, single carriageway road.
- The cottage is accessed via a pea-shingled drive which leads to an area for parking cars at the rear.
- Please be aware that the pathway is grassed and uneven in places.
- There is a large, shared garden with three picnic tables. One picnic table is intended for the use of Mattress Cottage guests.

The cottage is arranged as follows:

#### **Ground Floor:**



Entry into small hallway with utility cupboard to the right, entry to the kitchen in front and large sitting / dining area on the right. Spiral staircase leading to the first floor of the cottage.

#### First floor:

Staircase leads to small landing space with twin bedroom to the right. There are two 2 steps to the next corridor with the king-size bedroom, single bedroom and bathroom off of this corridor

#### **Arrival & Parking Facilities**

There is undefined parking to the rear of the property. The entrance is to the front of the building, accessed via the pea-shingled drive and grass pathway.

#### Getting in (and out) of the cottage

- The key is held in a keysafe which is 1320mm from the ground, to the left of the front door.
- The doorway has a small step 80mm high, the doorway is 890mm wide and 1810mm high.
- The lock is 870mm from the ground. There is a mat well inside the doorway.

#### **Ground floor**

#### **Entry hallway**

- The hallway is max 1860mm x 3500mm and is L-shaped.
- There is a 100mm step to the stairway and sitting/dining room the width of the hallway is 890mm.
- The ceilings and doorways are of varying heights the lowest being 1770mm.
- There is a spiral staircase to the first floor.
- The lobby has vinyl flooring.
- The utility cupboard in the hallway houses the washer / drier machine and a small freezer.





### Kitchen



- The kitchen has vinyl flooring.
- The doorway into the kitchen is 810mm wide.
- There are units on two walls with a small wall cupboard.
- The height of the worktop is 910mm.
- The kitchen has an integrated oven and grill, an under-counter fridge freezer, a dishwasher and a microwave.
- There is a table that is 750mm high with 3 stools (530mm high with a knee height of 210mm) and a chair (seat height is 430mm)
- Heating in this room is provided via a wall-mounted electric heater.

# Sitting / Dining room





- This room is carpeted with a hearth rug.
- The doorway into the sitting / dining room is 760mm wide.
- There is a dining table (720mm high with knee height of 270mm) and 5 chairs (seat height 460mm).
- There is a large inglenook fireplace with a log burner and a wall-mounted electric heater provides further heating.
- There are two sofas (seat height 400mm and depth 570mm) and an armchair (seat height 500mm).



- Other furniture in this room includes a small side table and a chest which can be used as a coffee table.
- There are two overhead lamps, a standard lamp and a table lamp.


#### **First Floor**

The staircase is spiral with 11 treads. The narrowest width is 760mm. The treads are between 170mm and 200mm deep. The steps are triangular from 1mm– 350mm. There is a rope handrail anchored by steel pins.



#### **Twin Bedroom**

- The doorway into the twin bedroom is 700mm.
- The height of the two single beds are 560mm and they are 900mm wide.
- There is a ceiling light and table lamp.
- There is a small fitted wardrobe and a small chest of drawers.
- Heating is provided by a wall-mounted electric heater.





### **Double Bedroom**



- The doorway to the double bedroom is 810mm wide.
- The height of the bed is 620mm and the width is 1540mm.
- There is a ceiling light and two table lamps on bedside tables.
- There is a fitted wardrobe and a small chest of drawers.
- Heating is provided by a wall-mounted electric heater.

#### Single Bedroom



- There is a small corridor leading to the single bedroom with two steps down into the room.
- The height of the bed is 570mm and the width is 90mm.
- There is a shaker rail for hanging garments and a chest of drawers.
- There is a ceiling light and table lamp.



#### Bathroom

- There is vinyl flooring in the bathroom.
- There is a bath (530mm high with internal dimensions of 560mm wide, 1520mm long and 400mm deep) with two grabrails.
- An electric shower is fitted over the bath.
- The sink is a pedestal basin (800mm from the floor to the basin).
- The toilet height is 400mm.
- There is a shaver lamp and a ceiling lamp.



## Garden

- There is a large, shared garden in front of the cottage.
- Outdoor seating is provided for each cottage on the site.
- There are bench seats next to each cottage entrance.



#### **Additional Information**

Assistance dogs are welcome at all our cottages.

In the event of a fire, it is the responsibility of the guests to evacuate themselves. Vibrating fire/smoke detectors are available if requested at time of booking. Please contact us if you have any other specific access requirements in this respect.

# Facilities at all cottages

The National Trust aims to expand the list of accessible /equipment/items available at each cottage and these may include

- Cordless kettle
- Hollowfibre bedding
- Chair with armrests
- Good reading light
- Large handle vegetable peeler



- Easy tin opener
- Non-slip mat for bath/shower
