Introduction

- Old Mill cottage is an isolated 15th century cottage in the heart of Brockhampton Estate
- This chocolate box cottage is set in a hilly landscape with a stream running next to it
- The cottage does get quite a bit of sun, but there is plenty of shade from the trees around it, including an old willow tree in the front garden

The Cottage is arranged as follows: **Ground Floor:**

- Sitting room, kitchen / dining room
- First Floor:
- Hallway bedroom, small landing with single bedroom and bathroom

Arrival & Parking Facilities









- You approach the cottage via a narrow country lane. The cottage is through a farm gate off this lane.
- There is a very steep farm track over the field to the cottage, due to its high gradient we do not recommend low slung vehicles to go down the track, it is approximately 0.4 miles to the cottage.



- There is another farm gate nearer the end of the track, the gate needs to be closed behind.
- There are two large wooden double gates to open to the area for parking; this is a fairly level area.
- The Parking area is 32 metres away from the cottage





Getting in (and out) of the cottage







- From the parking area, there is a gravel path that slopes down and with four separate small steps down, the highest step being 90mm.
- There is gate with an opening of 1100mm, there is just a simple chain attached to keep this closed.
- This then leads to the bridge across the stream; the bridge is 5550mm long and 770mm wide.
- There is a step at the end 150mm high on to a gravel path, the path bends and goes up and down in a half crescent shape so it is not level.
- This leads to the front door, there is a stone step 60mm high and then another step 40mm high into the cottage.
- The key safe is on the right side wall of the cottage, it is a scroll number combination safe.
- The doorway has an opening of 940mm







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Getting around the cottage

Ground floor:

- The front door opens onto quarry tiled surface, this is throughout the sitting room and kitchen, there is a loose rug in the sitting room
- There are two doors between the kitchen and the sitting room, one has an opening of 840mm and the other is 940mm
- There is a door to the stairway 700mm wide, there are 12 steps the highest being 210mm. The stairs are carpeted, and there is a handrail on the one side.



First floor:

- The stairs lead straight to the hallway double bedroom
- There is a door with 710mm wide opening and a step 130mm up to a small landing.
- The small landing has three doors off it, the single bedroom, bathroom and a cupboard with hanging space. The door widths are 730mm with the exception of the cupboard being 600mm.

Kitchen / Dining Room

- Height of worktop is 900mm
- The kitchen tap is a mixer with separate push controls for hot and cold
- Electric cooker
- Microwave, fridge with ice box, cordless kettle and toaster
- Dining table is one that opens up, the table height is 760mm
- There are three dining chairs they all have backrests and a seat height of 460mm





Sitting Room

- One sofa with seat height of 430mm
- One armchair with seat height of 460mm
- There is a traditional rocking chair with a seat height of 410mm







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Single Bedroom

- Single bed with 900mm (3ft) wide mattress
- Bed height 600mm





Bathroom

Hallway Double Bedroom

Bed height 610mm

WC, basin and shower over bath

Double bed with 1500mm (5ft) wide mattress

- The WC is 420mm high
- The sink is 800mm high
- The bath is 570mm high from the floor, it is
 1500mm long and 570mm wide at the top and has a depth of 470mm with two hand rails at the side
- The taps are separate turn taps for hot and cold and lever taps are on the shower for ease of use.

Garden

- Large enclosed area around the cottage, including the stream, therefore young children need to be supervised outside the cottage.
- Picnic bench is provided, the table height is 730mm and the seat height is 460mm





Additional Information

- Assistance dogs are welcome at all our cottages
- In the event of a fire, it is the responsibility of the guests to evacuate themselves. Vibrating fire/smoke detectors are available if requested at time of booking. Please contact us if you have any other specific access requirements in this respect.
