

National Trust Cottages Accessibility Guide (Nov 2019)

Chapel Cottage Peakside Ravenscar Scarborough YO13 0NE

Introduction

- Sleeps 4 in a ground floor apartment of a 2-storey stone cottage. This is an attached building, formerly a chapel. Located in a complex of National Trust buildings in the village of Ravenscar.
- The area is hilly with views over Robin Hood's Bay; it is close to countryside and farmland for walks.
- Biomass heating. Thermostat control in corridor next to bathroom door at 1430mm. Controls on each radiator. Timer panel on wall in kitchen.
- Access to the cottage may be difficult during severe winter weather.
- The bedrooms and bathroom are on the ground floor, but the cottage may not be suitable for wheelchair users as there are two carpeted steps to the main bedroom.
- Please note that there are sheep in the surrounding farm fields.
- WC on septic tank.
- Cottage is adjacent to High Peak (020036)

Pre-Arrival

Approach

- Travel directions are clear and should be followed carefully. NT Coastal Centre on brown road signs.
- Sloped, uneven approach.



Arrival & Parking Facilities

- An area for parking is available 10-15m from the cottage entrance. 2 un-marked parking spaces are available.
- Bulkhead lighting (PIR) is provided on the approach.
- Alley between cottages has a net width of 930mm and leads to a side door. Oblique step en route at 95mm.
- Surfaces are of compacted gravel and stone flags.
- The key safe is located to the right of the doorway, 1540mm high from ground. The code is sent with the booking confirmation details.



- One stone step of 120mm into the cottage.
- Clear width of the main white timber door is 580mm (690mm gross) to weather bar. Internal threshold of 25mm.
- Handle at 1050mm from ground level.
- Bulkhead lighting (external switch) in the area of the door.

Getting around the cottage

The cottage is arranged as follows:

Ground Floor:

Kitchen. Sitting/Dining Room with views over the bay. One double bedroom, and one twin bedroom. Bathroom with shower over bath. Internal door clear widths range from 690mm – 730mm.

First floor:

Very steep staircase – closed off and not accessed by guests. Baby-gate.





Kitchen

- U-shaped kitchen.
- Height of the worktop is 925mm from floor level.
- Circulation is reasonable but the room is compact.
- Lights in ceiling, under cupboards, and above the cooker.
- Mixer stub-lever taps provided to sink.
- Stand-alone cooker (height 900mm) and ceramic hob.
- 50/50 fridge freezer.
- Microwave.
- Slimline dish-washer
- Washing machine (no dryer).
- 40mm carpeted step to Sitting/Dining Room

Sitting / Dining Room

- Fire door from Kitchen into Sitting room 800mm wide.
- Double aspect windows looking over Robin Hood's Bay.
- 2 x two-seat sofas with a seat height of 420mm.
- 1 wing arm-chair 460mm with good armrests.
- Dining table at 760mm height with 4 chairs at 440mm seat height.
- 1 x table lamp and 1 x standard lamp.
- TV / Freesat / DVD / CD & Radio.
- 2 x radiators.
- Carpeted flooring.





Inner hall

- Minimum width 1100mm.
- 1 x radiator
- 2 x carpeted steps (1 x 140mm and 1 x 170mm) leading to double bedroom.



Bathroom

- Door 640mm clear width.
- Bath with integral hand-grips. External height of bath 540mm. Internal height 370mm. Narrowest width is 480mm between hand-rails. Pillar cross taps.
- Glass screen to shower over bath. Mira Sport electric shower, at 1450mm to centre of controls from bottom of bath.1380mm from bottom of bath to bottom of the riser bar.
- Close coupled toilet; seat height 410mm.
- Basin 800mm high.
- Lights either side of mirror, above basin.
- Combined radiator and towel rail.
- Vinyl floor



Double bedroom

- Door width from inner hall 720mm.
- Divan bed is 2000mm long by 1500mm and 600mm high.
- 2 x bed-side lights
- 1 wing arm-chair, seat height 460mm; 1 x occasional chair, seat height 450mm.
- 2 x radiators
- Carpeted floor
- Fire exit door 800mm clear width; thumb screw lock; 50mm high threshold; leading to external steps. Level space at top of steps measuring 1000mm wide by 1060mm long. 6 x stone steps each 200mm high. Handrails on both sides of level space and steps. Steps end in garden, on uneven grassed area.

Twin bedroom

- Door width 720mm.
- Two divan beds are both 900mm wide, 1900mm long and 600mm high.
- Maximum 550mm between beds.
- Bed-side light between beds.
- 1 x radiator.
- · Carpeted floor.





Garden

- Small garden laid to lawn with rotary washing line.
- Dog-friendly garden.



Additional Information

Facilities at all cottages

- Hollowfibre bedding
- Chair with armrests
- Large handle vegetable peeler
- Non-slip mat for bath/shower
