Honor's Cottage Snowshill



Property Ref 006007

Introduction

The property is situated in the village of Snowshill opposite Snowshill Manor with direct access onto the lane. There is a steep, terraced and enclosed back garden behind. It is the middle of a terrace of Cotswold stone cottages. Within the terrace there are three other holiday cottages - Spring Cottage, Manor Farmhouse and Diston's cottage.

Honor's Cottage sleeps up to three people in two bedrooms. It has an open plan ground floor.

It is heated by night storage heaters and has a wood burner in the sitting room. There is a shared outside laundry room (with Manor Farmhouse)

There are areas of restrictive ceiling height and exposed roof beams and trusses upstairs

The Cottage is arranged as follows:

Ground floor

 Kitchen area, open plan sitting/dining room with large inglenook fireplace and wood burning stove

First floor

• Two bedrooms (one double and one single) and bathroom with shower over bath

Approach

The properties are approached via well maintained country lanes

Arrival & Parking Facilities

- There is no outside lighting so if arriving after dark it is advisable to have a torch
- Allocated parking is available in the gently sloping National Trust Staff car park just past the property and on the other side of the lane
- It is possible to pull in and unload from a vehicle at the front of the property before parking

Getting in (and out) of the cottage

- Front door width 810mm, height 1730mm, no threshold
- Approach to front door is directly off the lane and through a porch canopy area with concrete floor/path
- Key box with a dial combination to the left, height 1430mm
- Suffolk latch and Yale lock
- Door opens directly into the open plan sitting/dining room/kitchen





Getting around the cottage

Ground floor

Open plan ground floor with good circulation Old quarry tile flooring, uneven in places Wooden pillar within the room Narrow access to the kitchen sink

Stairs to the first floor are half turn with a flat half landing, 660mm by 1700mm and is carpeted. Stair height 190mm, tread 230mm, width 860mm.



The bottom stair has a height of 100mm, tread 210mm



First floor


Reduced head height at the top of the stairs due to sloping ceiling, min edge height 1500mm There are two carpeted landing areas. Main landing area 840mm by 1400mm Back landing area 870mm by 840mm

Exposed/raised beam between landings 620mm in length, 160 in width and 80mm high Restrictive ceiling heights due to exposed beans, trusses and sloping ceilings

Ground Floor Open Plan Kitchen/Sitting Room/Dining room



Kitchen area

- · Quarry tile floor
- Height of worktop 910mm
- Fitted kitchen with under counter cupboards and shelving above
- Slim double electric oven and hob, under-counter fridge with freezer box, microwave
- Windows with views to the front lane
- · Ceiling halogen spotlights
- Narrow corner sink area, width 490mm
- · Mixer twist taps with washers



Sitting/Dining room area

- Flooring is a continuation of the quarry tiles, uneven in places, rug with anti-slip underlay
- Wood burner in large inglenook fireplace
- 1 x two-seater settee, seat height 457mm, depth 689mm
- 1 x loveseat, seat height 457mm, depth 689mm
- Dining table, height 710mm, space under 690mm,
- 3 x chairs, seat height 450mm, window seat, seat height 550mm
- 3 x wall lights, 2 x floor lamp with foot switches, 1 x table lamp with switch on lead
- Low central beam 1720mm
- Central wooden pillar
- Window to the front with views over the lane, half glazed door and side window with views over the back garden.



Double Bedroom

- Door width 730mm, no threshold, Suffolk latch
- Continuation of landing carpet, sloping floors
- Divan bed, width 1340mm, length 1900mm, height 610mm
- One side table with lamp, switch to lead, pendant ceiling light
- Window with views over the lane and the grounds of Snowshill manor
- Chest of drawers and hangers on the back of the door, height 1680mm
- Chair, seat height 460mm
- Trusses/beams restrict circulation around one side of the bed

Single Bedroom

- Door width 710mm, no threshold, Suffolk latch
- Continuation of landing carpet, sloping floor
- Single divan bed, height 635mm
- Side table with table lamp, under lampshade switch, ceiling pendant light
- Window with views over the lane and grounds of Snowshill Manor
- Chest of drawers & hangers on the back of the door, height 1700mm
- Restrictive circulation, sloping ceiling, exposed trusses and beams





Bathroom

- · Door width 720mm, no threshold
- Linoleum floor, sloping
- Toilet height 420mm, lever handle
- Bath height 600mm, taps ceramic lever
- Shower over bath with screen
- Sink height 780mm with washer twist taps
- Shaver socket, height 1460mm
- · Good circulation, 900mm by the side of the bath
- · Ceiling light, no window

Garden

- Access to the garden is via back door with an immediate step up of 110mm, leading onto gravelled area which in turn leads to the laundry room.
- Uneven steep stone steps lead to a terraced area of lawn with further uneven steep steps up to a further two levels of lawn.
- Top garden has two wooden benches and the middle garden has a Bistro metal garden set, table height 750mm, seat heights 470mm (with arm rests)

One step up to laundry room, 100mm high with threshold of 40mm, step down into room



125mm. Door height 1765mm, width 635mm
