Introduction

Berwick New House barns form part of the farm complex at Berwick New House on the Attingham Park estate. The barns were built between the late 1700s and the late 1800s. Tern Barn is on the left side of the right barn, as shown in the picture above and is now a comfortable countryside retreat for four people.

From the entrance hallway, you will find the kitchen and a sitting room with a dining area and woodburning stove. Upstairs, there is a double bedroom, a twin bedroom.

The five barns share an enclosed garden, with a lawn, a firepit ready for barbecues and a dining patio. Outside the barns you will also find car charging points, a bicycle store and a dog shower.

The Cottage is arranged as follows:

Ground Floor:

On the ground floor, the hallway leads to an open-plan kitchen, dining and sitting room area with a woodburning stove.

First Floor:

Upstairs, there are two bedrooms, a king (5ft) bed, a twin with two single (3ft) beds, and the bathroom.

Pre-Arrival

- Please drive slowly along the driveway.

Arrival & Parking Facilities

- Access via a single track.
- There are two parking spaces for Tern Barn in the shared parking area. There are shared electric vehicle charging points.
- Access to the property from a vehicle to the entrance door is approximately 2000cm via a concrete pathway.
- Around the cottage is all on a flat level with a combination of compacted gravel, concrete or tarmac path from the back door to grassed area. The seating area is a compacted gravel area.
- The key safe is located next to the front door.



Getting in (and out) of the cottage

- The Key safe for Tern Barn is on the left-hand side of the front door.
- The front door (image 1) leads to the hallway and has a step up of 25cm and a step down of 10cm. The door has an opening width of 107cm and a height 190cm.
- There alternative access door (image 2) leads from the sitting room to the garden and has a step up of 6cm and a step down onto the patio of 24cm. The width of the door is 89cm and the height is 199cm.

Getting around the cottage

Ground floor:

- The hallway has a vinyl floor covering.
- From the hallway the door on the right leads to an open plan kitchen, sitting room with a dining area and has an open width of 77cm and a height of 198cm.

Kitchen

- The height of worktop is 93cm
- There is an electric cooker, dishwasher, washing dryer, cordless kettle, toaster, microwave and fridge/freezer.
- The floorcovering in the kitchen is vinyl.

Sitting Room with Dining Area

- There is comfortable seating for 4 people provided with a seat height of 45cm.
- The coffee table height 43cm
- There is a television with DVD player and a music centre.
- There is a log burner with child safety guard.
- There is a large table with a height of 74cm and a height beneath for leg access of 66cm.
- The table seats 4 people with a seat height of 45cm.

First Floor

The first floor is reached by a carpeted stairs that turns up three flights to reach the landing. The landing leads to:

Bathroom

- There is a WC, basin and bath with a shower over it.
- The WC is 39cm with seat raised and 43cm high with seat down. The toilet has a push button flush.
- The basin 85cm high with an adjustable mixer tap.
- The bath is 54cm high from the floor, it is 151cm long, 53cm wide, and the depth is 38cm. The bath has an adjustable mixer tap.
- The floor has a vinyl floor covering.



Main Bedroom

- Located through a door, with an opening width of 78cm and a height of 196cm, from the carpeted first floor landing is the main bedroom. This has a king (5ft) bed. The height of the bed is 63cm.



Twin Bedroom

- Also located from the first floor landing, is the twin bedroom. The door leading into it has an opening width of 77cm with a height of 196cm.
- The twin bedroom has two single (3ft) beds. The height of each bed is 63cm.



Garden

There is a shared enclosed garden between the five cottages, this is fairly level and laid to lawn. Outside the cottage there is a patio with a table and chairs to seat 4 people.



Additional Information

- Assistance dogs are welcome at all our cottages
- In the event of a fire, it is the responsibility of the guests to evacuate themselves. Vibrating fire/smoke detectors are available if requested at time of booking. Please contact us if you have any other specific access requirements in this respect.

Facilities at all cottages

The National Trust aims to expand the list of accessible /equipment/items available at each cottage and these may include

- Cordless kettle
- Hollowfibre bedding
- Chair with armrests
- Good reading light
- Large handle vegetable peeler
- Easy tin opener
- Non-slip mat for bath/shower
- Non-slip place mat
- Easy jar opener
- Information in alternative formats (on request)
