Introduction

- The cottage can accommodate four people.
- LPG Combi boiler central heating throughout.
- Wood burner in sitting room and dining room.
- Parking available for two cars.
- Dogs permitted at the property.

Ty Cipar is arranged as follows:

Ground floor

• Sitting and dining room with a multi-fuel stove in each, kitchen, shower room with a toilet, wash basin and shower, utility and games room.

First floor

One twin bedroom and one double bedroom accessed by stairs.



Games Room

Large room converted from a stable with seating, dart board, table tennis, pool table and telescope.

- Please bring a torch if arriving in the dark as there are no streetlights here.



Approach

 Access to this cottage is directly from a good B road onto a hard-core area leading to a fivebar gate to a slate gravel parking area in front of the cottage.

Arrival & Parking Facilities

- The key to your cottage will be in a key safe just to the right of the front door. The
 combination will need to be entered to open the key safe this should also enable the key
 safe to be closed.
- Side and rear garden area with washing line. Front slated parking area with five bar gate entry.



Getting in (and out) of the cottage

- The front step is 13cm up into the porch.
- The step into the hall is 7cm.
- The front door has a clear opening width of 85cm.
- Porch to hall door is 85cm wide.
- The back step is 3cm door jamb leading to a 18cm step up into the games room.
- The back door has a clear opening width of 82cm.

Getting around the cottage

Ground floor:

Level access from front porch door through lounge, dining room utility, shower, kitchen
and into games room with a raised step of 14cm to access the main part of the games
room.



- Internal clear opening door widths on the ground floor are; hall to living room 67cm, hall to dining room 73cm, living room to utility 60cm, utility to shower room 67cm, living room to kitchen 71cm, kitchen to games room 67cm.
- Downstairs is hard floor, tiled, with lino in the shower and wooden floor in the games room. The stairs and small landing and all bedrooms are carpeted.
- In the living room the sofa is 42cm to the top of the seat cushions, the chairs are 47cm.
- The dining room table is 77cm high and the matching chairs are 48cm to the cushions.
- The kitchen worktops are 92 cm high as is the cooker.
- In the shower room the toilet is 40cm high, the sink 85cm and there is a slight step into the shower of 5cm.

First floor:

- Both bedroom doors are 73cm wide.
- The master bedroom has a standard size double bed at 65cm tall to mattress top, with a chair whose base in 47cm.
- The twin has two single beds at 60cm high and a chair at 50cm high to base cushion.



Getting around the cottage

Sitting Room


- One sofa.
- Two armchairs.
- One occasional lamp stand.
- Wood burning stove.
- Main ceiling light.
- Good natural light from the window to the front.

Kitchen

- Good range of kitchen base and eye level units.
- LPG Gas cooker.
- Fridge with freezer section, electric toaster, and kettle electric and stove top.





Dining Room

- Wooden table with four chairs
- Book shelves with small selection.
- Fridge with freezer section, electric toaster, and kettle electric and stove top.



Master Bedroom

- Double bed.
- Chair.
- Dressing table with mirror.
- Bedside table with a lamp on each side.





Bathroom

- Shower with glass screens.
- · Close coupled toilet.
- · Sink with mirror over.



No separate WC

Twin Bedroom

- Two single beds.
- Chair.
- Bedside table with lamp between beds.
- Mirror.

Garden

Enclosed medium sized garden area with picnic bench and clothes' line.

Additional Information

- One dog is welcome at this cottage. Please keep your dog under control around sheep/livestock and ensure the garden is kept clean.
- Please do you your utmost to keep your pet off the furniture for the benefit of following guests.
- In the event of a fire, it is the responsibility of the guests to evacuate the property. Vibrating
 fire/smoke detectors are available if requested at time of booking. Please contact us if you have
 any other specific access requirements in this respect.
