Introduction

- . Traditional stone cottage set in the castle grounds
- . Semi detached
- . The cottage can accommodate four people plus a cot
- . The cottage heating is from air source heat pumps
- . Wood-burning stove in sitting room
- . Enclosed front garden with open space and patio area at rear.

The accommodation is arranged as follows:-

Ground Floor

Hall, sitting room, kitchen, dining room.

First Floor

1 double bedroom, 1 twin bedroom, bathroom with WC and separate Shower.

Pre-Arrival

- . See the main webpage for booking and location details
- . Please contact us prior to booking if you have any specific access requirements
- . Directions provided with booking
- . Bring torch if arriving in dark.

Approach

- . The cottage is set within the Castle grounds. The approach to the cottage is through the grounds of the castle itself. Guests will need to follow the instructions sent with the booking information with care.

Arrival and Parking Facilities

There is parking at the rear of the cottage.

- . The key-safe is in a black box outside of the front door and on the right (as facing). It is operated by a push button mechanism. A torch is recommended especially if arriving in the dark as the numbers on the box can be difficult to see. The key is returned to the key-safe on departure.

Getting in and out of the cottage

- . A gravel path leads you through the front garden
- . There is a step into the porch at the front door. This is 14cm high. The step into the house is 8cm high.
- . The door has a clear opening width of 86cm.

Getting around the cottage

- . Level access throughout the ground floor
- . Internal door width to lounge is 70cm. To kitchen is 75cm. To dining room is 71cm.
- . The lounge, hall and dining room have carpeted floors.
- . The kitchen has linoleum flooring.
- . Steep staircase 100cm wide, 75cm between bannisters either side with each step being 19cm high and the handrail on both sides at 78cm.
- . Upstairs is carpeted apart from the bathroom which is vinyl flooring.
- . Hallway between the lounge and dining room is 98cm wide.

- . Carpeted
- . 75cm between bannisters
- . Bannisters are 78cm high

Sitting Room

- . Two grey herringbone pattern sofas with a seat height of 50cm
- . Wood burning stove
- . Good natural light from the windows
- . Lighting from ceiling rose and wall light.
- . Additional grey metal reading lamp on side table.

Kitchen

- . Directly off sitting room
- . Lighting is LED round ceiling rose
- . Height of worktop is 91cm
- . Electric cooker with ceramic hob
- . Dishwasher, 70/30 fridge- freezer, washer/dryer
- . Microwave, kettle, toaster



Kitchen

Dining Room

- . Wooden table and 4 grey leather-style seated wood chairs
- . Height of table is 76cm with maximum clearance underneath of 60cm
- . Dining chairs have seat height of 48cm.
- . Good natural light from window at front, side and rear of room.
- . 3-drawer console is 79cm high
- . 3-drawer, 2 cupboard sideboard is 86 cm



First Floor:

- . There is a 4cm step down into the bathroom.
- . Window ledge at top of stairs is 50cm
- . All floors are carpeted apart from bathroom, which has vinyl flooring
- . Good natural light from all windows
- . All internal doors upstairs have a clear opening width of 70cm: twin 79cm, bathroom 70cm and double bedroom 74cm

Double Bedroom

- . Double Divan bed 75x135x197 (6'6")
- . Bedside lights in addition to ceiling light
- . Built in wardrobe

- . Tall mirror behind door
- . Good natural lighting
- . Bedside tables are 65 cm high.
- . Small cabinet under mirror, behind door is 59cm high and is next to 2 plugs.



Double Bedroom

Twin Bedroom

- . Door width is 78cm
- . Divan Beds are 75x85x183 (6')
- . Bedside light at each side of chest of drawers.
- . Built in wardrobe.
- . Bedside window ledge 61cm, window ledge, door-facing, is 76cm
- . 2-drawer tallboy is 84 cm with tri-fold mirror and 2 lamps
- . 78.5cm tall square grey plant stand type table

Twin bedroom

Bathroom and WC

- . 4cm step down into bathroom
- . Shower step is 24cm high
- . Small ledge 24cm high
- . Shaving plug and light above basin mirror
- . Basin is 80cm high
- . WC is 42cm high
- . Acrylic bath is 54cm high
- . 41cm between edge of WC and bath
- . Daikin boiler behind the double doors in the bathroom
- . Radiator at door, towel radiator next to shower.



Garden

- . Vinyl rattan-style garden furniture
- . 2 seat 42cm high, 2 armchairs 42cm high and table
- . Wooden benches 41cm
- . Wooden table 69cm

- . Assistance dogs are welcome at all our cottages
- . Up to 2 dogs are allowed at this cottage
- . There is a TV with free sat and a DVD player at this cottage
- . In the event of a fire, it is the responsibility of the guests to evacuate themselves. Vibrating fire/smoke detectors are available if requested at time of booking. Please contact us if you have any other specific access requirements in this respect.
