## Opening hours

The Bath Skyline is open countryside, open 24 hours a day

## Admission prices

- No admission charge

## Location

- Countryside on the southeast side of the city of Bath
- The land comprises of a circular route (called the Bath Skyline walk), with many starting/access points
- The nearest point to the city centre is Bathwick Fields on Bathwick Hill (point 1 on the property map). There is a bus stop here (Bathwick Hill at Cleveland Walk)
- The nearest train station is Bath Spa, 0.8 miles (1.3km) from the start of the walk

## Parking

- There is no National Trust car park for the Bath Skyline
- There is no other designated car park
- The nearest car park is Manvers Street car park, 0.7 miles away – route follows public pavement, steps, inclines
- Roadside parking may be available nearby, but often with time restrictions.

## Paths

- There are some flat sections of path (points 7-10 on the Bath Skyline walk map)
- There are also steep and uneven sections of path, going uphill and downhill
- Path surfaces are: woodland path, over grass, roadside pavement, stone path
- Some paths can be slippery and very muddy in wet weather and in the autumn/winter
- Along the paths there are kissing gates, self-closing gates and steps
- Routes cross busy roads in places

## Toilets

- There are no toilets on the Bath Skyline
- The nearest public toilets are in Sydney Gardens, 0.7 miles from the start of the Bath Skyline walk.
- There is a changing places toilet at Sydney Gardens
- Other public toilets

## Trails

There are three waymarked trails:

- Bath Skyline walk – Hilly and uneven surfaces, 6  $\frac{3}{4}$  miles, about 4 hours
- Walk to the View – mostly flat and even surfaces, one steep climb, small kissing gates and a stile, 3 km, 1½ hours
- Family Discovery Trail and Access for All Trail – Flat, access for all friendly, wide self-closing gates, stone surfaces plus two flat fields, 3km, about 1 hour.

There is some overlap between these trails, especially the Skyline Walk and the Access for All trail
