



Accessibility information

On arrival: short but fairly steep (1:9) surfaced path from the accessible parking to the reception. If this will prove difficult, it may be easier to make use of the Drop-off and collection point shown.

Surfaces: main route to the top of the garden is via a tarmac drive which starts at the reception. This runs uphill for $\frac{3}{4}$ mile with an average gradient of 1:15. All other paths are gravel, with a short section of grass across the house lawn (marked O on the map).
