Accessible walks

A Trampler is available to hire from Visitor Welcome. For a wheelchair-friendly route, we recommend the step free walk in the Abbey garden.

Estate walks

All three walks start from the Cart pond, taking in views of the Tavy Valley.

The Abbot's 'yellow' walk (1 mile)
Step-free Trampler and buggy-friendly.

Drake 'red' walk (2½ miles)

Amicia 'blue' walk (3 miles)

Don't miss the spring bluebells, welcome shade in the summer and spectacular autumn colours.

We welcome dogs

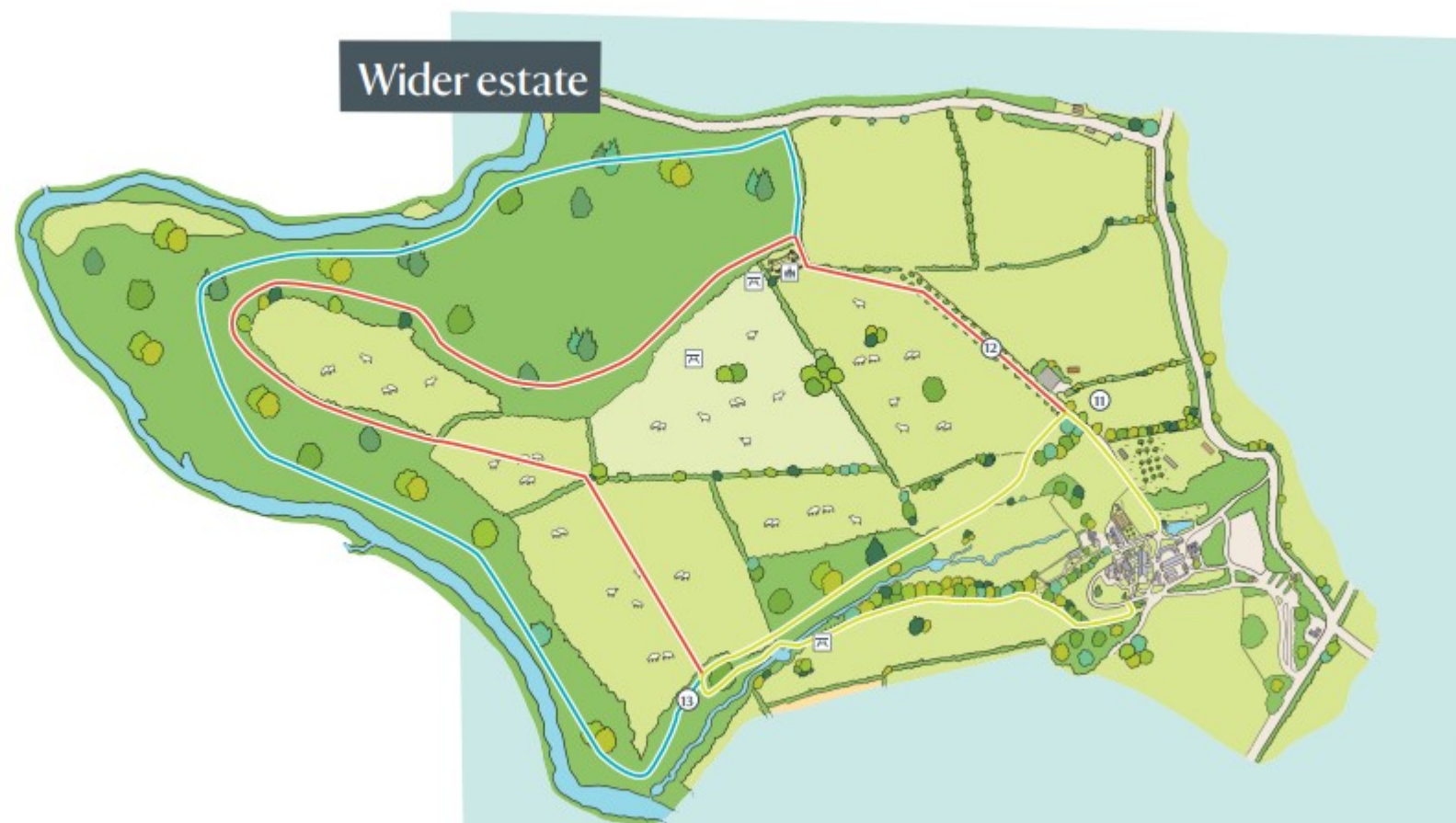
