#### Accessible walks

A Tramper is available to hire from Visitor Welcome. For a wheelchairfriendly route, we recommend the step free walk in the Abbey garden.

#### Estate walk

[1] All three walks start from the Cart pond, taking in views of the Tavy Valley.

The Abbot's 'yellow' walk (1 mile) Step-free Tramper and buggyfriendly.

Drake 'red' walk (2½ miles)

#### Amicia 'blue' walk (3 miles)
