

Saltram East



Welcome to Saltram East, Plymouth's new country park.

The National Trust has opened up more than 32 hectares of green space, creating new opportunities for the people of Plymouth to connect with nature and heritage.

Supported by Sport England Lottery Funding and The National Lottery Heritage Fund, new multi-use trails and a boardwalk link Saltram East with the wider parkland, revealing restored views across Plymouth and towards Saltram House. Newly establishing wildflower meadows and habitats are helping to create a richer landscape for wildlife and strengthen Plymouth's green corridor.

Use this map to explore the four trails and discover this landscape. For walks within the main estate, please see the estate map.

Turnpike Trail ▲

This walk starts from the car park hut and takes you to the start of the new country park. You will need to turn back on yourself to return to the car park. This is a shared path.

Difficulty: Easy – moderate

Time: 30 minutes

Distance: 2.2km (1.3 miles)

Dogs: Please follow signs

Accessibility: The start of the walk contains an initial gradient which at the steepest section is 1:7 for approximately 25m. It then levels out to a flat, smooth path 2.2m wide with resting points.

Meadow Path ●

This walk is a circular loop that includes the adjoining Turnpike trail. The path takes in views of the estate and establishing wildflower meadows. This is a shared path.

Difficulty: Moderate

Time: 60 minutes

Distance: 3.7km (2.3 miles)

Dogs: Please follow signs

Accessibility: The surface is flat and smooth, with a section of path containing a slight gradient. The path is 3m wide and has areas with resting points.

Wixenford Way —

This walk is a circular loop that includes the adjoining Turnpike trail and Meadow path. The path takes in views of the city, before reaching views of the estate and establishing wildflower meadows. This is a shared path.

Difficulty: Moderate

Time: 70 minutes

Distance: 4.5km (2.8 miles)

Dogs: Please follow signs

Accessibility: The surface is flat and smooth. The path is 3m wide and has areas with resting points

Dell Walk ♦

This walk gives you an alternative route to reach the car park. It takes you across a newly built boardwalk before joining the existing Dell Walk. This is a shared path.

Difficulty: Moderate

Time: 70 minutes

Distance: 4.5km (2.8 miles)

Dogs: Please follow signs

Accessibility: Contains a 200m stretch of path with a gradient of 1:11, this area contains two benches. This then levels out to a flat, smooth 2.2m wide path. The boardwalk is 2.3m wide.
