Car Park (not National Trust)

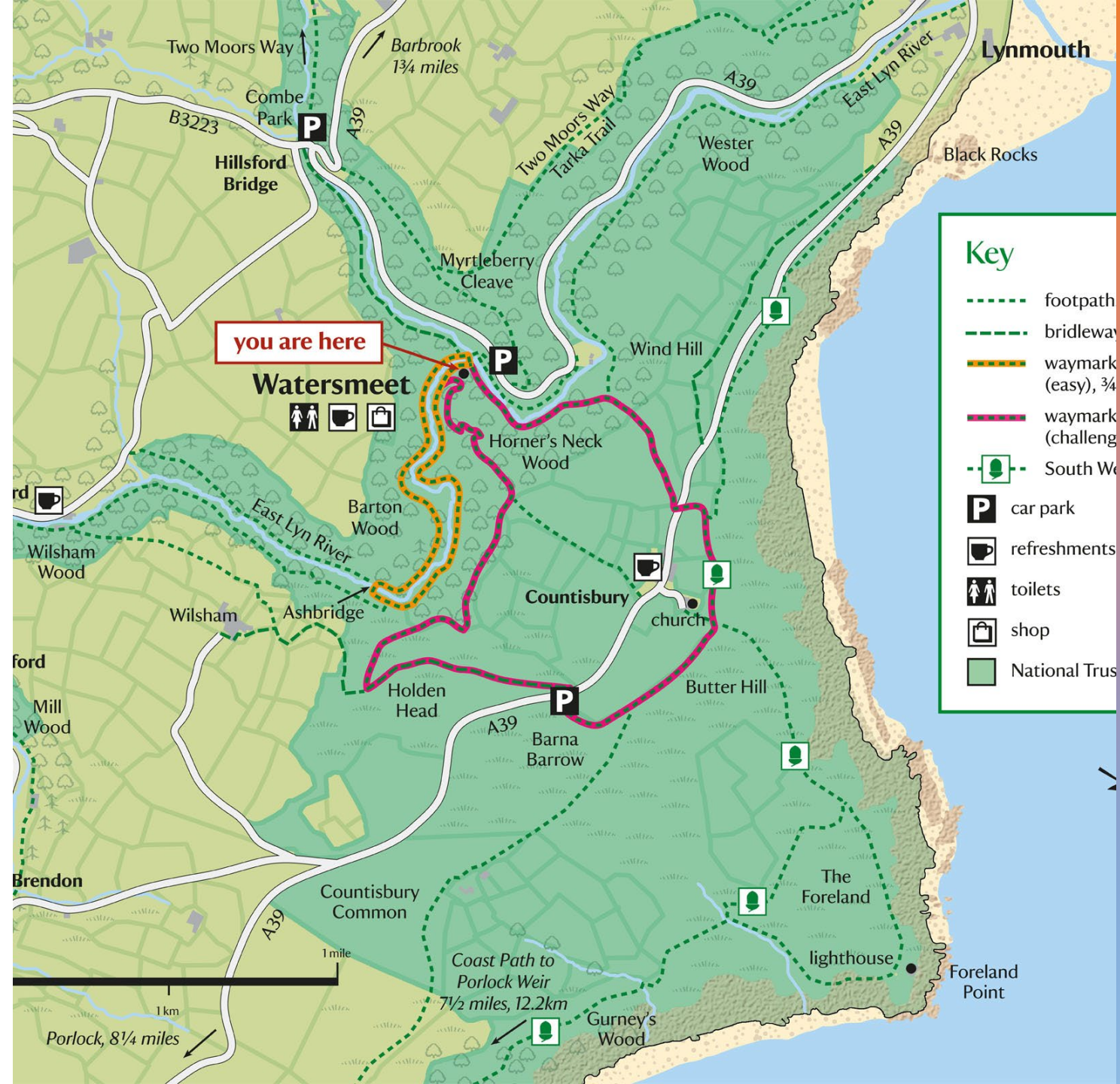
- A pay and display (not National Trust and only accepts coins) car park on A39 above Watersmeet House. There is however a steep walk from here to Watersmeet house/tea -oom.
- There are 2 Blue Badge parking bays.
- The nearest National Trust car parks are at Combe Park and Countisbury. Combe Park is a more gentle 1 mile walk, Countisbury is more strenuous, especially on the way back.





Routes around Watersmeet

- Numerous waymarked routes to choose from to explore the rich woodlands of the Lyn Valley and stroll along the riverside.





Tea-room

- Indoor and outdoor (verandah or riverside garden) seating available.
- Refreshments are available from the servery counter





Toilets and baby changing

- The nearest toilets are behind the tea-room.
- Here you will find ladies and gents toilets, baby changing and an accessible toilet
