# Car park

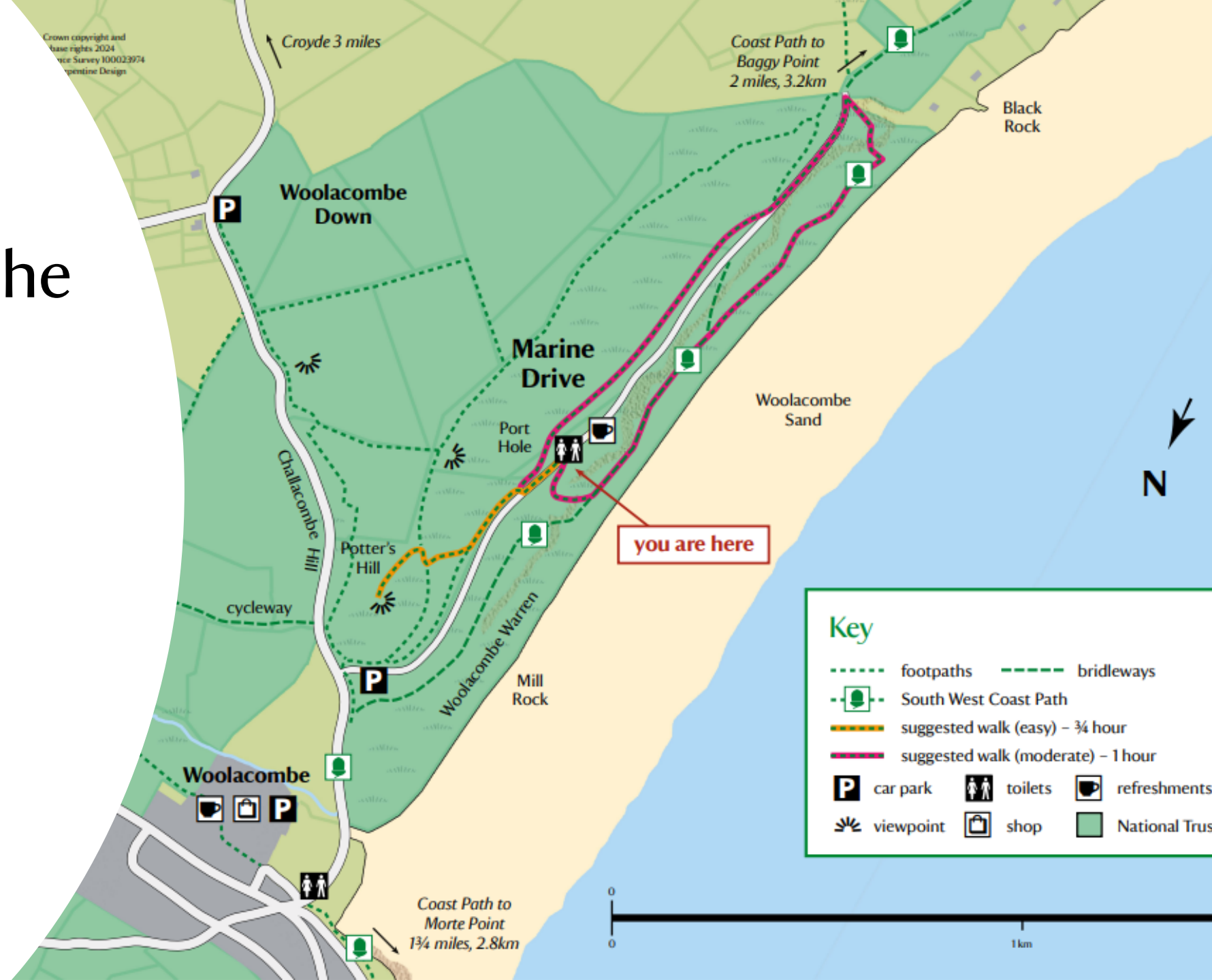
- You will arrive in the car park and see our welcome hut. This is where you can scan your National Trust card or pay for parking if you are not a National Trust member. If the hut is not staffed you can do both of these on the Just Park app.
- Should you require Blue Badge parking, designated spaces are available part way along the car park near the Porthole Café. These are clearly signposted, although they are some distance from the entrance.
- The car park is a long linea car park so you may have to travel along it to find a space in busy times.





# Routes around the property

- This is the map of the car park and surrounds.
- The routes around the dunes and surrounding area are often steep and uneven.





# Electric Vehicles

- Four 22kW electric vehicle charging points are available at Marine Drive car park.
- Chargers can be accessed using mobile app, RFID card, or contactless payment device.
- Visit our EV charging provider RAW Charging's website ([rawcharging.com/drivers](http://rawcharging.com/drivers)) to download the app before your visit.



## Powered Mobility Vehicle

- A Trampler is available as part of the Countryside Mobility scheme from the Tourist Information Centre. It is best to book in advance. Telephone 01271 870553.
- There are three marked tramper routes - across the beach, across the dunes and up through Combesgate valley.





# The Porthole Café (not National Trust)

Small cabin serving hot drinks, ice creams and sandwiches, using local produce.

## Toilets and baby change

- The nearest toilets are at the Porthole Café (not National Trust).
- Here you will find an accessible toilet/ladies toilets/gents toilets and baby changing facilities.
- The hand driers in the toilets make a loud sound.
- Please note they are open when the café is open.
