# Speke Hall, Garden and Estate

Explore the estate and discover stunning views across the Mersey estuary, hidden corners of ancient woodland and what's in bloom in the historic garden. Some walks have uneven surfaces and challenging slopes in parts.

For an accessible route suitable for wheelchairs, pushchairs and assistance dogs, follow the blue route on the map and enjoy a relaxing stroll with beautiful views of the house and gardens.

The distance from the Visitor Welcome building to the House Entrance is 350m. Walking at a gentle pace this will take about 10 minutes.

> The Victorian Home Farm building now houses our restaurant, pre-loved book shop and visitor facilities and is open 7 days a week.

The restaurant prepares fresh food everyday and serves breakfast options, lunches from 12-2.30pm and hot drinks and delicious cakes throughout the day. The food is locally sourced with some veg and herbs grown here at Speke in our Kitchen Garden.

#### **Visitor Information**

- The toilets, including baby changing facilities, are located at Home Farm and in the Dairy Courtyard.

### Dog Walking

- Great walks to enjoy with your dog are the Coastal Path, The Bund and Woodland Walk. For a shorter walk, rest and relaxation head for the Orchard, North Lawn, South Lawn or the Secret Garden. Please keep pet dogs on a short lead at all times when visiting.
