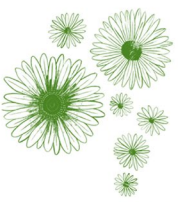

## Weekend of Wildlife



### Walks and activities timetable:

Sign-up in advance at the Information Point or drop-in at the Meeting Point to see if any spaces are free:

- 10:30am – 11:30am Looking for invertebrates (bug hunting)
- 11:00am – 11:45am River dipping
- 11:00am – 12:00pm Bird walk
- 12:00pm – 1:00pm Looking for invertebrates (bug hunting)
- 12:30pm – 1:15pm River dipping
- 1:30pm – 2:30pm Looking for invertebrates (bug hunting)
- 2:00pm – 2:45pm River dipping
- 2:00pm – 3:00pm Butterfly walk
- 3:00pm – 4:00pm Looking for invertebrates (bug hunting)

### Drop-in activities throughout the day near the white bridge:

- 10:00am – 4:00pm Speak to our **visiting stallholders** about their work for wildlife and visit our **Information Point** to find out how you can take part today.
- 10:00am- 3:30pm **Explorer packs and spotters** - borrow one of our guides or Explorer Packs to find and record wildlife for yourself out in Morden Hall Park. (Packs are lent out until 3:30pm as these need to be returned by 4pm).
- 10:00am – 4:00pm **Meet the riverflies** - take a look at some of the water invertebrates that we find as part of our monthly river health survey, known as riverfly monitoring.
- 10:00am – 4:00pm **Discovery Zone** get hands on with magnifiers, animal models and more

Children must be accompanied by an adult throughout this event. Some activities are less suitable for very young children - please ask if you require further details. Please keep your dog on a lead.

Throughout this event, our team will use the free online wildlife observation system iNaturalist to record the living things seen. You can see what has been recorded so far here, and add your own records to the species total:
