Accessibility

Stowe Gardens can be challenging, though we're working to make it as accessible as possible. Most pathways are gravel or hoggins. Mown grass paths can be slippery when wet. There are steep slopes and uneven steps in places. Please follow the suggested paths based on your level of mobility.

Free Access Equipment

Call **01280 817156** in advance to book manual wheelchairs or mobility vehicles. If using your own, please fully charge your vehicle before setting off.

Car Park, Shuttle Service & Entry

There is accessible parking at New Inn approx. 100m from the Visitor Centre and shuttle stop. From here it is around 800m to the garden entrance. If you need assistance getting from the car park to the shuttle stop please call **07990 771841** or ask a team member for help.

Cafe, Shops & Monuments

There's level access from the car park to the Visitor Centre, café and shop at New Inn. The Parlour Rooms, second-hand bookshop, and most of the monuments have steps.

The Path for All - 4k

Enjoy the beauty of Stowe at your own pace. The Path for All covers the main garden highlights via the most accessible route. With wider paths, shallow gradients, sensory spaces, and plenty of rest spots, this route is suitable for everyone.

The Stowe House Path - 3.5 km

This is the easiest and most accessible route around the gardens for those wishing to visit Stowe House. (Please note: Stowe House is not NT owned and needs to be booked separately). We recommend you return the same way to avoid steep slopes and narrow paths.

The Gothic Temple Path - 3.5 km

This is the most accessible route for those wishing to visit the Gothic Temple. We recommend you return the same way to avoid steep slopes and uneven terrain.

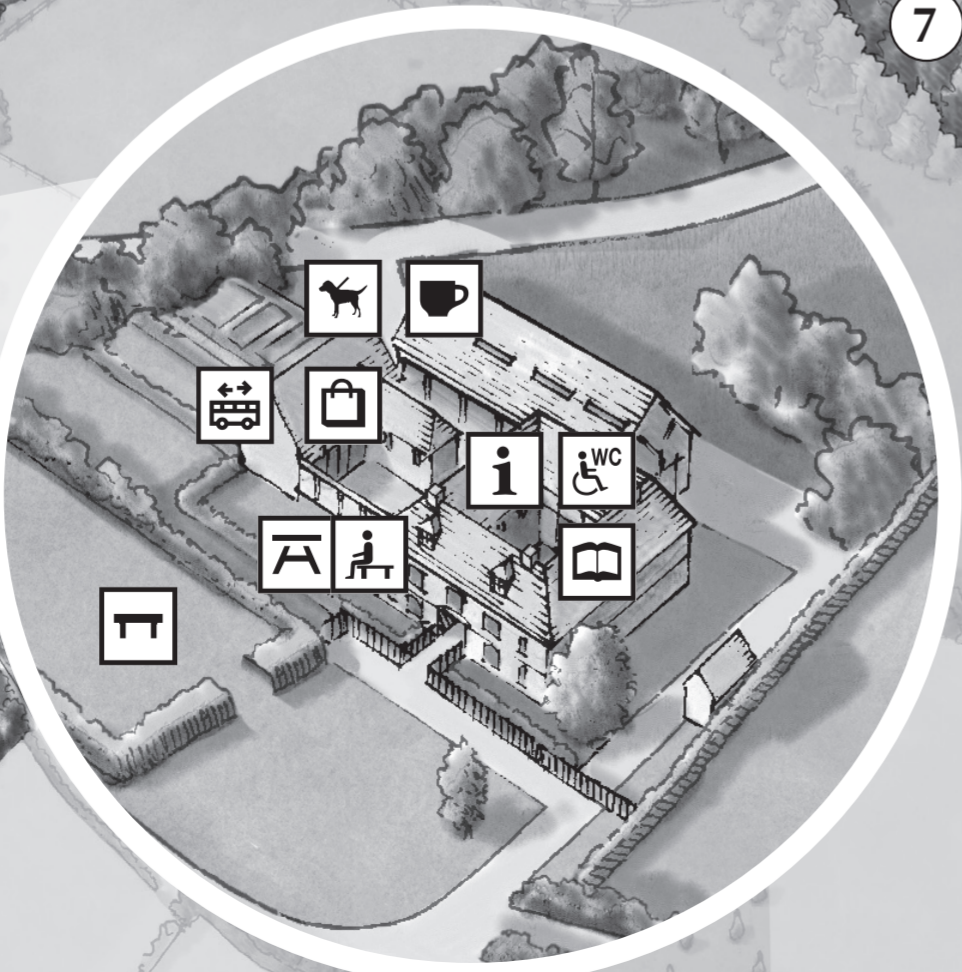
Use our free shuttle service from New Inn to the entrance at Bell Gate.
