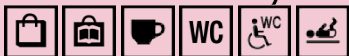

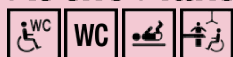

4 Pleasure Grounds

Mile Walk—1 mile

5 Walled Garden and Field of Play



The **Walled Garden**, built in the 1780s, provided the Mansion with produce until the 1960s. Today we use the produce in the café, as well as for sale in the shop.

6 Deer Park

The **Deer Park** is home to a abundance of wildlife. Please keep to the paths to help protect wildlife habitats and the historic parkland.

Deer Park Walk—2 miles
Including adjoining Mile Walk path, Suitable for PMVs with extra stability features.

Woodland Walk—3 miles
Including adjoining Deer Park and Mile Walk paths. Suitable for National Trust Tramper PMV only.

WWII Walk—4 miles
Including adjoining Woodland, Deer Park and Mile Walk paths. Not suitable for PMVs.

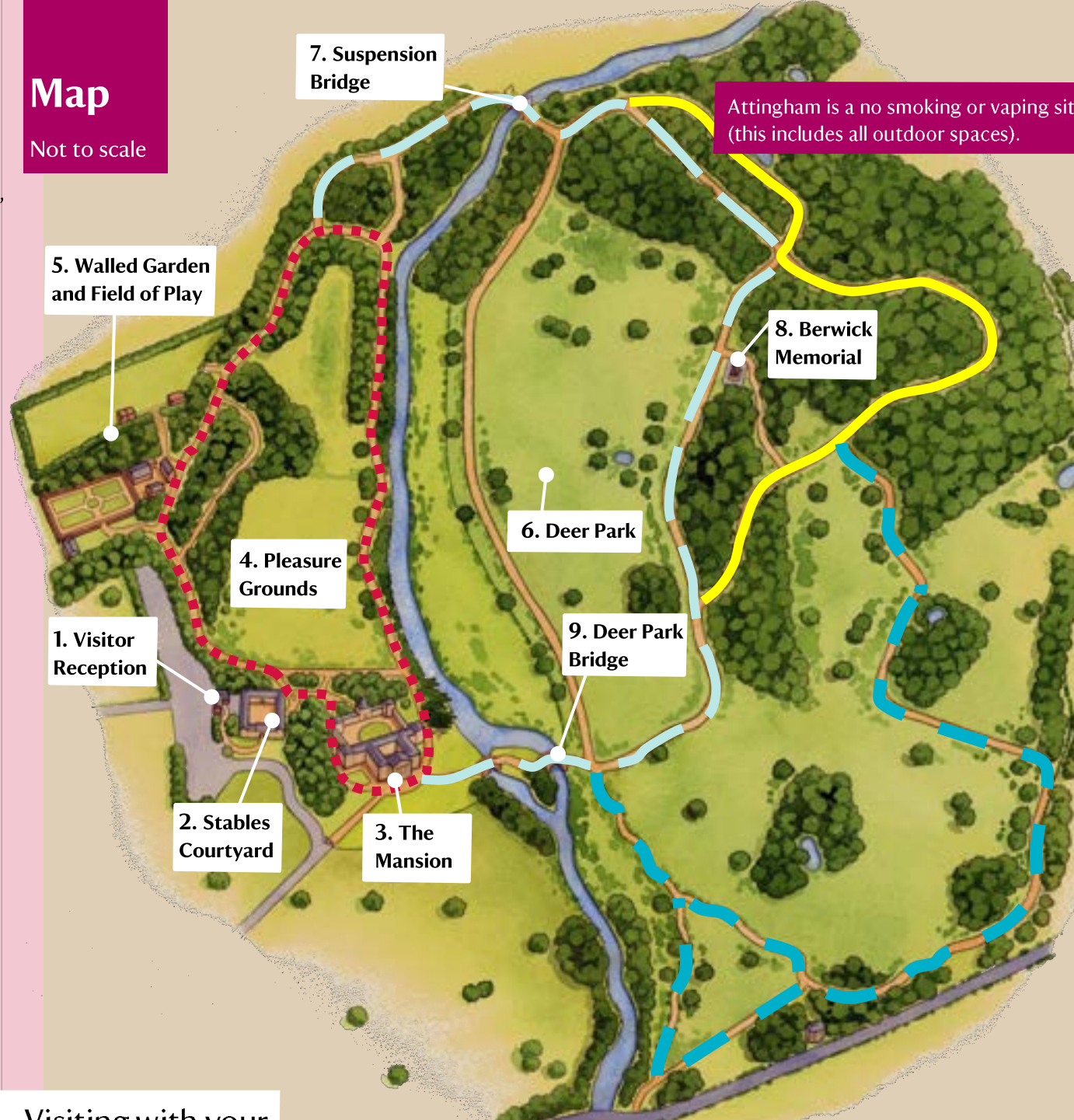
