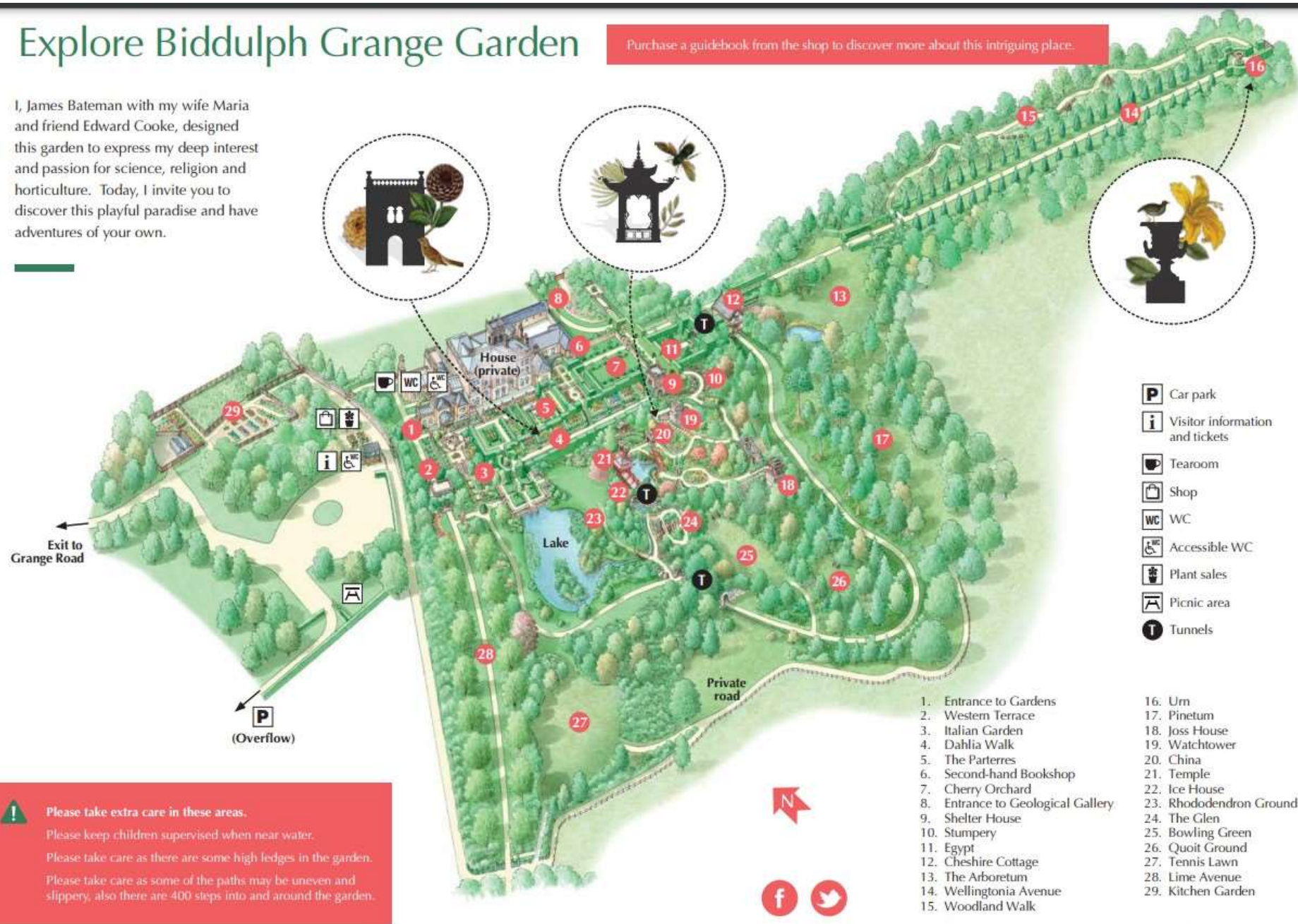


# Explore Biddulph Grange Garden
