River Wey Navigations

The River Wey & Godalming Navigation consists of 20 miles of navigations and is nationally significant as one of the earliest waterways to be made navigable and is cared for and owned by the National Trust. The National Trust is a private charity and is completely independent of government funding and relies on income raised from membership, donations and legacies, and revenue from our commercial operations. All mooring and Licence fees contribute to helping look after, maintaining and conserving our unique waterway and all our special places for everyone, for ever.

LONG TERM MOORINGS AND DRY STORAGE

Fees – Moorings are classified either standard grade or basic grade depending on their proximity to the Thames and standard of mooring area (car parking, water, rubbish/sewage disposal, overhanging trees, jetties, ease of access etc). Details of the mooring sites and grades can be found on the application form attached to this information sheet.

As from **January 2026 Standard Grade** moorings will be **£3.93 per metre per week plus vat** and **Basic Grade** moorings **£3.42 per metre per week plus vat**, payable quarterly in advance by direct debit. Moorings are charged to the nearest 0.10 metre. The following examples of our charges are per quarter and include vat.

Dry Storage fees will be **£2.40** per metre per week plus VAT at Stoke Lock where there is a slipway and **£1.96** per metre per week plus VAT at Stonebridge Wharf.

Registration - Please complete the attached form and return it to the Navigations Office. Please advise us immediately of any change of address, telephone number or requirements.

Availability & Waiting Lists – We currently have moorings available at a number of locations across the Navigations. While some of our most popular sites may have a waiting list, being flexible on location can often help secure a mooring sooner. Once you have accepted a mooring, you may remain on the waiting list for your preferred location should you wish to move in the future. Please note that only one mooring per person is permitted

Method of Offer - When a vacancy occurs which matches your requirements, we will write to you asking you to contact us within ten days to confirm whether or not you are interested. We recommend that you visit the site before making your decision. If for any reason we do not hear from you within ten days, we shall offer the vacancy to the next person on the waiting list. An offer is made **subject to the attached conditions** which should be read and retained for future reference.

Craft for Sale - From time-to-time craft are sold on their moorings, though this is only possible once a mooring contract has been held for a period of 12 months or more. If you would like to receive details of craft for sale with their moorings, please indicate on the attached registration form and we will put you on our mailing list. Please note that a fee is payable if a National Trust mooring is to be transferred with the purchase of a boat.

Craft Dimensions - Locks pass craft 21.9m in length and 4.2m beam. The maximum beam for jetty moorings is 2.15m. At normal water levels, draught is 90cm to Guildford and 75cm to Godalming, and headroom 2.15m to Guildford and 1.85m to Godalming (Broadford Bridge).

Navigation Licences - All craft afloat on the Navigations **are required to be licensed**. Licences run from January to December and fees for annual licences for the year 2026 are:

Any craft new to the navigations part way through the year will be charged a pro rata fee based on the Prompt Payment fee above.

Residential Mooring - is not permitted on the River Wey Navigations. Residential wardens, appointed by the Navigations Manager, are allowed to stay on their boats at specific locations to provide voluntary security and other duties for mooring lines.

MOORING CONDITIONS

1	It is the responsibility of mooring holders to regularly check the safety, security and condition of their boat. This is particularly important during periods of bad weather.
2	All craft must be licensed annually. You will need to provide evidence of insurance and a Boat Safety Scheme certificate. If your insurance is third party only, we shall require written confirmation that wreck recovery and salvage is included.
3	Craft are not permitted to be used for residential purposes. The only time that you are allowed to stay overnight on your boat on your mooring is the night before setting off on a cruise or the night you return or when you are actually cruising along the Navigations and moor up next to the towpath. If for some unexpected reason, you need to stay an extra night on your boat, you should contact Trust staff on site or the Navigations Office in Guildford.
4	Designated vehicle parking areas for which an access key payment is collected are for use by moorers using or accessing their craft and should not be used at any other time or for any other reason.
5	Craft should only be secured to the mooring rings, stakes or eyes provided within the allocated length and moorers should not use their own stakes or chains, or tie to any part of the jetty or sheet piles.
6	Appropriate fendering must be attached to the craft (ideally traditional rope fenders). Tyres must not be used since they can jam lock gates and paddle gears if they come loose, causing the possible closure of the Navigations.
7	In the interests of security, the mooring area should only be used for access to your craft. To discourage general public access, for sale signs should not be displayed and the area should not be used for fishing, picnics, barbecues etc.
8	The banks should not be used for temporary storage of flower troughs, bench seats, tenders, bonfires, etc. No planting (other than grass seed) to take place.
9	Dogs should be kept on a lead until on board or outside the mooring site. Please remove any dog faeces from the mooring pathway.
10	All refuse should be bagged and taken away. No rubbish should be left on the bankside.
11	Please note the National Trust byelaws prevent the sale or offering for sale of any commodity on Trust property without prior permission.
12	The sale of a boat on its National Trust mooring is not permitted unless the mooring contract has been held for a period of at least one year. If the boat is sold without the mooring and is to remain on the River Wey Navigations, the new purchaser must have a bonafide mooring authorised by the Navigations Manager.
13	National Trust Byelaws and the Wey Navigations Conditions of Usage must be complied with at all times.
