

Lianbedrog Car Park Access Statement

Introduction

- 1. The property is a level car park which holds approximately 170 vehicles.. The entrance only allows one vehicle in or out at a time.
- 2. Mobile phone reception is good. In an emergency visitors should call 999 (or 101 in a non-emergency situation.)
- 3. Assistance dogs are welcome. All dogs are welcome in the car park, in the welcome cabin and on the beach. A water bowl is available at the welcome cabin. There are no dog hitching points. There is shade on one side of the car park but we discourage visitors from leaving their dogs in their vehicles.

Arrival & Parking Facilities

- 1. There are general signs to the beach from the main road (300 metres) and a parking sign at the entrance to the property.
- 2. There are 3 specifically designated parking areas for disabled visitors and parking is free on production of a blue badge.
- 3. The car park surface is gravel with potholes which fill with rainwater
- 4. There is no transfer vehicle to the beach
- 5. It is possible to drop off visitors at the beach. The access road is very narrow and the drop off driver may need to reverse approximately 200 metres back to the parking area.
- 6. Access from the car park to the beach is via a flight of 40 stone steps with a handrail on both sides. Alternative access is via a tarmac access road of approximately 200 metres which is accessible for powered and manual wheelchairs but is uphill on the way back.
- 7. There are three picnic tables on a grass surface and one picnic table on a gravel surface. The access to the gravelled area is 87 centimetres wide and to the grassed area is 1.5 metres wide.
- 8. Interpretation is via visual signage. There is no tactile or audio information available.

WCs

- 1. There are public toilets (Gwynedd Council) which are not designated as accessible. These are situated on the tarmac road (150 metres from the car park entrance). They can also be accessed from the steps. The toilet block entrances are narrow and the cubicles are small and confined. They are not suitable for wheelchair access.
- 2. There are no changing facilities for children or adults.
- 3. The toilets are lit by some natural light and movement sensor bulbs. They appear very dark on first entry from the outside. There are no fluorescent bulbs.
- 4. The toilets have cold water, no soap and automatic hand driers.



Visitor Reception

- 1. The welcome cabin is all hard surfaces with plaster walls and a stone floor.
- 2. The entrance is level from the car park.
- 3. The entrance door is two metres wide.
- 4. The entrance door is manual opening (inwards) and is left open at all times when the cabin is operational.
- 5. There are two reception desks. One is 67 centimetres high. The other is 100 centimetres high. Staff can come around the desk and a clipboard is available for visitors to use on their lap.
- 6. The area is well lit by natural light and LED bulbs. There are no fluorescent lights.
- 7. There is a variety of chairs available.
- 8. There is no induction loop available.
- 9. Staff/volunteers are seasonal and do not normally have any particular communication skills such as BSL.
- 10. No wheelchairs are available for loan.
