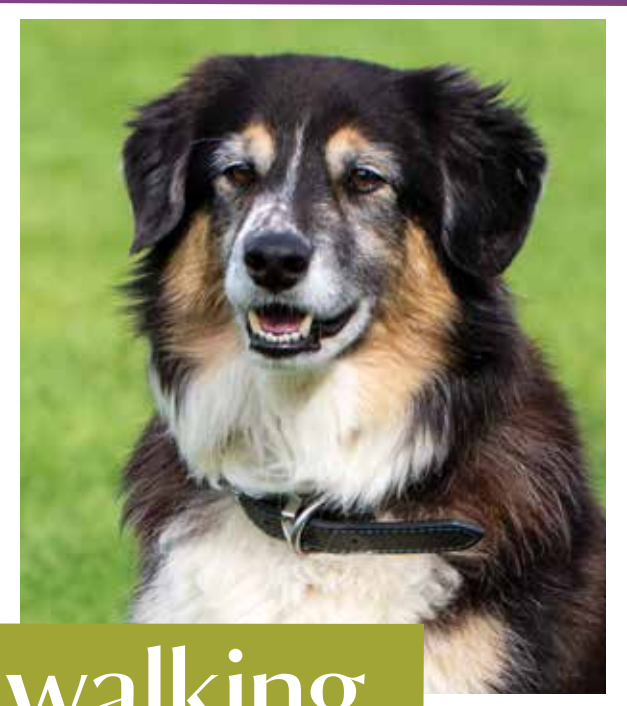




Dog walking at Charlecote Park

The Canine Code

Take the lead

Please keep your dog on a short lead at all
times and stick to the designated dog
walking route. Dogs are not allowed off the
lead anywhere at Charlecote Park.

Scoop that poop

Please always clear up after your dog.
There are designated bins along the dog
walking route but if you can't find a bin
nearby, take the poo bags home with you.

Assistance dogs

Only assistance dogs are allowed inside
any of the historic buildings.

Treats at the café

Dogs are welcome inside the Wood Yard
café and Orangery. There are hitch points
on the benches outside in the Wood Yard
too, just look for the paw-print symbols.

Be on the ball

Not everyone loves dogs so please keep
your dog close at all times. Other dogs may
prefer space even if your dog is friendly.

Paws for thought

Look out for information signs and take
extra care around livestock. Stick to the
clearly marked dog-walking route at all
times. This will help with the conservation
of our wildlife and livestock.

Water, water everywhere

Water bowls are located around the main
buildings. Please stay safe by staying out of
the rivers and the lake.

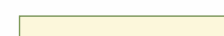

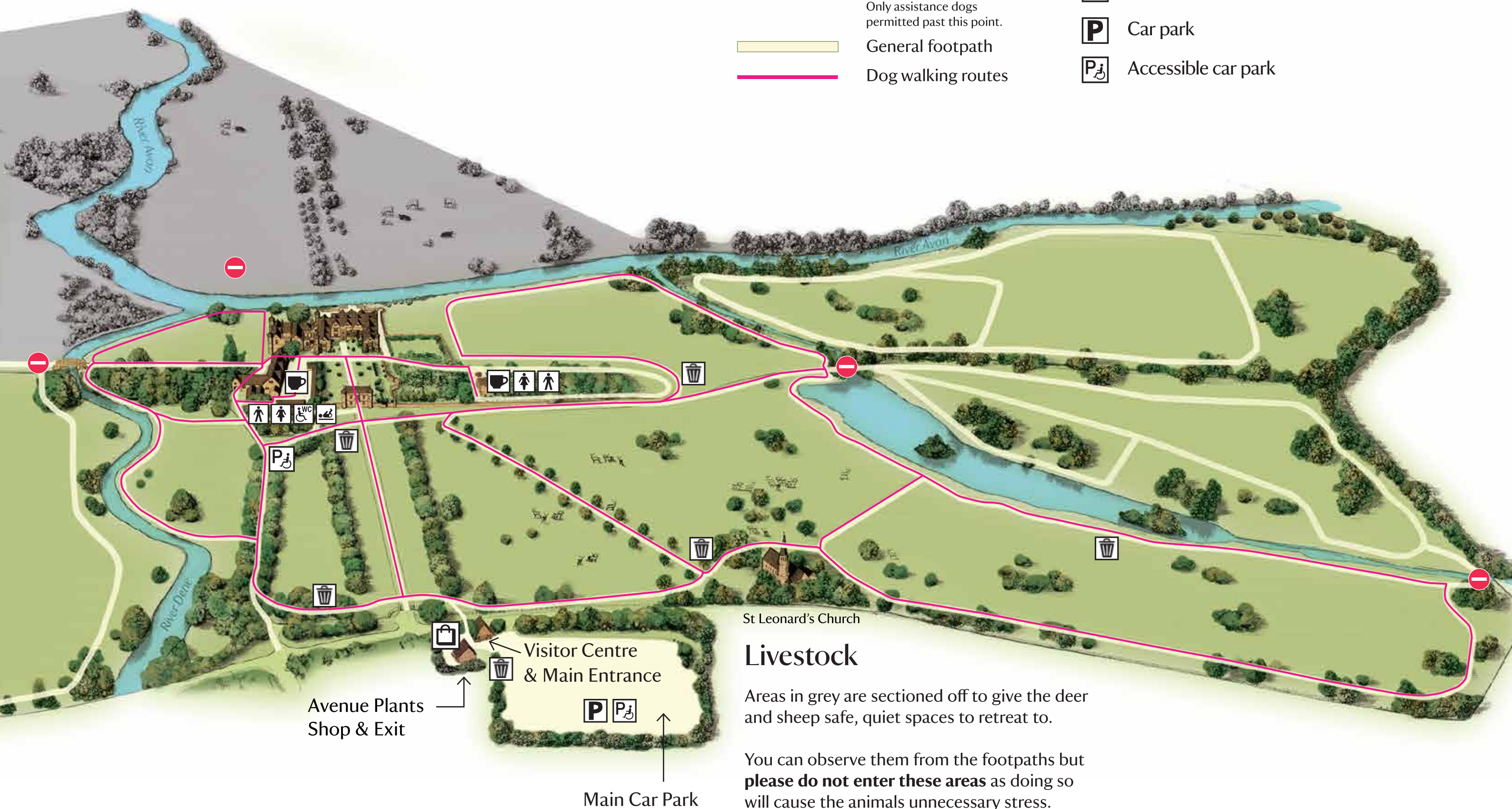
