Recommended routes

- Original garden path as taken by the Hoare family and their guests 3.5km (2.2 miles), around 1½ hours
 - Accessible route 2.7km (1.7 miles), around 1 hour
- It is 0.5km (0.3miles)/10mins from visitor reception to the house, and from visitor reception to the lakeside garden entrance.*

- Keep dogs on short-fixed leads and pick-up after them. Dog waste bins are in the car parks.
