Chedworth Roman Villa is one of Britain's largest Romano-British villas. It nestles in a wooded coombe in the heart of the Cotswolds and is managed by the National Trust. We offer talks/lectures to interested groups and societies at their usual venues as part of our outreach programme.

Our main talk includes: the pre-Roman history of the site; relevant Roman history; the Villa's initial establishment in the 2nd Century AD and its development through the 3rd Century to the magnificent 4th Century villa. We then cover its demise at the end of the Roman era and its discovery in the 19th Century. We can tell you about contemporary Roman hospitality; the Villa's fine mosaics; current archaeology and future plans.

When: We aim to offer talks at times and dates to suit you including at short notice.

Where: We will travel up to a 50 mile radius from Chedworth Roman Villa and further afield by special arrangement.

Speakers: Our speakers are trained National Trust volunteer site guides with a strong knowledge and enthusiasm for Chedworth Roman Villa and British Roman history. If you have a preference as to speaker, please say so and we will try to accommodate your wishes. And if you have a particular interest we will try to adapt the talk to suit your requirements.
