- Visitor route – Dog on lead, but may be extendable lead
- Visitor route – Keep your dog on a short lead, not exceeding 2m
- Public footpath – Your dog may be off the lead, under effective control

What do we mean by effective control?

Dog owners should always ensure their dogs do not disturb wildlife, livestock or people. This may mean keeping your dog on the lead or in sight at all times when you are confident it will return to you on command, ensuring it does not stray off the footpath or designated area.

Horse Close

A designated 'Dogs off leads' area when there is no livestock. You are free to let your dog off the lead if you are confident they will promptly respond and return to your command.



For a longer walk you can join the public footpath at the Worcester Gates.
