

Danbury Common Access Statement

Bicknacre Road, Danbury, Essex

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Introduction

1. This is a countryside property with unmade and well used footpaths. There is likely to be mud in places and uneven surfaces, especially in winter months.
2. Areas in the north of the common have been mined for gravel in the past and as such there are some steep slopes
3. The common is crossed with bridleways. It is frequently used by cyclists and horse riders.
4. There are a number of benches throughout the common
5. Mobile phone reception is reasonable on most networks. In an emergency, please call the duty ranger on 07824 891420.
6. Dogs are welcome throughout the property and should be kept under control.
7. Visitors are asked to pay attention to signs on arrival which will notify them of any works being undertaken on site or particular hazards.

Arrival & Parking Facilities

1. There are two car parks – one at Penny Royal Road, and the other on Bicknacre Road, south of Plumptre Lane. There is no brown sign. For sat nav, use CM3 4ED or CM3 4JJ
2. There is no designated parking at Danbury Common. The car park surface is stone, and as such is uneven in places.
